Wake Forest 7, Florida State 2

TALLAHASSEE -- Wake Forest scored five runs in the top of the eighth inning to beat second-ranked Florida State 7-2 and take the rubber game of a three-game weekend series at Dick Howser Stadium.

The Demon Deacons are the first Atlantic Coast Conference team to win a series at Florida State. FSU drops to 32-9, 11-6 in ACC play. Wake Forest is now 24-12, 8-8.

Wake Forest second baseman David Hedgecoe drove in the go ahead run in the eighth inning with an infield single off of FSU reliever John Nedeau (2-1). It was the fourth hit of the afternoon for Hedgecoe.

The Deacons went through five Florida State pitchers in the decisive eighth, scoring five runs on four hits and four walks.

Seminole starter John Wasdin struck out 10 in seven innings. Nedeau came on in the eighth inning after FSU had tied the game in the bottom of the seventh on a Chad Sheffer sacrifice fly.

Wake Forest's Ross Atkins (5-3) picked up the win. Atkins scattered seven hits and fanned five before Bret Wagner came on to get the final five outs.

Randy Hodges had three hits for Florida State and Link Jarrett added a pair of singles. Brad Pryce collected three hits for Wake Forest, including a fifth inning home run that gave the Deacons a 2-1 lead.

Florida State returns to action Tuesday night, hosting Mercer at 5:30 p.m.
