SEMINOLES BLANK HURRICANES 1-0
...Wilson outduels Arrieta

CORAL GABLES, FL -- Mickey Lopez' two-out single in the seventh broke up a Fadul Arrieta no-hitter and scored Grady Jordan from second for the game's only run as fourth-ranked Florida State (35-9) defeated Miami (26-15) 1-0 Friday night at Mark Light Stadium.

Jordan led off the seventh with a walk and stole second, setting the stage for Lopez' heroics.

Seminole starter Paul Wilson (9-3) was superb. In recording his fourth spotout of the year, the sophomore righty retired the last 17 batters he faced, at er allowing four hits, Rick Ellstrom was the last Hurricane to reach base, as he singled to lead off the fourth, but was erased on a double play. Wilson did not walk a batter and fanned four. The shutout was FSU's eighth of the year and third in their last five games.

For Miami, Fadul Arrieta (4-4)also pitched a tremendous game, allowing only two hits over eight and one-third innings. Arrieta struck out ten, but walked a career-high five batters.

The loss represents the first time since 1975 that Miami has been shutout by the same team twice in the same season. Ironically, it was the Seminoles who accomplished the task then also.

Miami and Florida State play again on Saturday at 7:30 p.m. The series finale is Sunday at 1:30. Jose Prado (3-2) will face Jonathan Johnson (7-0) in Saturday's game two. In the fourth inning, the University of Miami will retire the #1 jersey of former coach Ron Fraser.
