HURRICANES OVERTAKE SEMINOLES 14-13
...Rupp's 2-out triple in tenth wins it

CORAL GABLES, FL -- Chad Rupp finished three-for-six with two home runs, a grand slam and nine runs batted in, as Miami came back from 8-0 down to beat fourth-ranked Florida State 14-13 in ten innings.

Rupp's two-out triple in the tenth provided the winning runs. Rupp leads Miami in home runs and RBI's with eleven and 45.

The Seminoles (35-11) took an 8-0 lead after three innings. Hurricane starter Silvio Censale didn't throw a strike, as he walked all three batters he faced. Grady Jordan delivered the big blow, a two run single scoring Doug Mientkiewicz and Mike Schmitz.

Trailing 8-0 in the fourth, Miami (28-15), loaded the bases for Rupp on a Dave Berg single, Alex Miranda walk and Keith Tippet reached on an error. Rupp smacked a grand slam, the first by a Hurricane this year, cutting the lead in half at 8-4.

FSU then increased the lead to 10-4 in the seventh when Chad Sheffer tripled to left, plating Scott Schroeffel and Jordan.

However, Miranda hit a three-run blast in the bottom of the seventh, reducing the lead to 10-7.

In the ninth, Berg and Miranda singled, and Keith Tippet sacrificed both to second and third base. Berg scored on a wild pitch by Seminole reliever Phil Olson and Rupp belted his second home run of the game, and eleventh of the year, evening the game at 10-10.

Florida State tallied three in the tenth to take a 13-10 lead. Walks to Mickey Lopez and Minkiewicz set the stage for a two-RBI double by Randy Hodges.

Miami wasn't finished as in the bottom of the tenth, Luis Hernandez and Berg walked and Rick Ellstrom singled, scoring Hernandez to cut the lead to 13-11. Tippet walked to load the bases and Rupp then provided the heroics with a bases-clearing triple, giving Miami the 14-13 win.

Friday's hard-luck loser Fadul Arrieta (4-4) earned the win in relief. Bryan Harris (5-3) took the loss.

Miami's next game is Friday, April 30 vs. Division II national champion Tampa. The Spartans were ranked fourth in the nation last week.
