FLORIDA STATE BASEBALL

Florida State 4, Clemson 3 (10 innings)

TALLAHASSEE -- Doug Mientkiewicz drew a bases loaded walk with two outs in the 10th inning to give eighth-ranked Florida State a 4-3 victory over Clemson in Atlantic Coast Conference baseball action Saturday night before a crowd of 2,950 at Dick Howser Stadium.

The victory was Florida State's first over the Tigers in the last seven meetings, since the Seminoles joined the ACC. FSU's win also broke Clemson's four-game winning streak. The Seminoles improved to 39-13 overall, 14-8 in the ACC, while the Tigers fell to 36-15, 10-11.

Mientkiewicz' walk scored Chad Sheffer, who doubled with two outs in the 10th off eventual loser Jeff Keppen (2-2). Sheffer went to third on a passed ball before Keppen walked Mickey Lopez and Link Jarrett to load the bases. Rodney Williams relieved Keppen and threw four straight balls to give FSU the win.

Seminole starter John Wasdin (9-1) pitched 10 innings to get the victory. Wasdin struck out nine, allowed six hits and walked three. He allowed only one hit after the fourth inning. Clemson scored its final run in the fifth on a sacrifice fly by Keith Williams.

FSU tied the game at three in the eighth. With two outs, Lopez tripled and Jarrett followed with an RBI double to set up extra frames.

Mike Schmitz collected three of FSU's eight hits in the game, including a solo home run, his eighth of the year, in the second. Shawn Satterfield led Clemson with two hits, including a solo home run in the third.

The Seminoles need a victory Sunday in the finale of the three-game set, and a loss by N.C. State, to take second place in the ACC heading into the conference tournament next weekend.
