GAME 2 POSTGAME QUOTES

**LOUISIANA STATE QUOTES**

**Coach Skip Bertman:**

"Paul Wilson is the real thing. He's the best pitcher, at least tonight, I've ever seen. He was driving the ball in. We were fortunate to get three runs. He's never lost a game where the other team got more than three (runs)."

**Russ Johnson:**

"He (Wilson) threw a great game on the outside (of the plate) and in. He's improved as far as hitting spots. The ball seemed to have movement coming back across the plate. When he got the lead, he dominated."

**Todd Walker:**

"The difference in the game was obviously Paul Wilson. It was a college baseball team facing a big league pitcher."

"Hitting's contagious. We lost it in one inning (the sixth). The other eight innings, we shut them out."

"You take the bad (pitches) and hit the good ones. That's what I'm doing."

**Scott Schultz:**

"It's amazing what can happen when you throw one bad pitch. It's unbelievable what can happen when one person leads it off and they get adrenalized."

"There was a lot more pressure on Paul Wilson. I had that one inning letdown."

**FLORIDA STATE QUOTES**

**Head Coach Mike Martin**

"Link (Jarrett) said he didn't know how to act. He's been here for 3 years and we've always been in here (the interview room as losing team) first."

"Our ball club is built on pitching and defense. Steven (Nedeau) really ignited us with the triple. It was a really big play for us."

"It was one of those games that you got a break and we took advantage of it and rode the train home."

**Paul Wilson**

I did think about the draft. I had a great outing. I wrote them (out offense) the past 2 games. Our offense game through in the Regional and now in the first game of the College World Series. I just went out there and did my job."

**Link Jarrett**

"We know a lot about them (Ga. Tech) and they know a lot about us. Even though we didn't play them in the league tournament, we know they're a competitive team and we're ready to play them."

On winning the 1st game: "It gives us a lot of confidence. A lot of first-time things have happened here and it's a lot of first-time things in my career."

**Steve Nedeau**

"He (Scott Schultz) was hitting in spots and it through our hitting game early. But Randy (Hodges) got that hit in the fifth and it got us going. After Randy got it going, I just keep it going and came in with the triple."

"We just started keying in on him (Schultz) and getting hits. Everybody got pumpled up. The ball that I hit the triple off of was an off speed pitch, a curve ball. The second hit I got, I couldn't tell you what the pitch was. I must have had my eyes closed or something."
