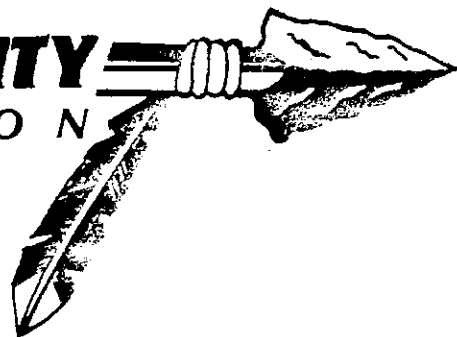

### **FLORIDA STATE BASEBALL TAKES TWO FROM NORTH CAROLINA**

CHAPEL HILL, NC -- Starting pitchers Randy Choate and Chuck Howell each earned their first complete-game victories of the season as No. 12 Florida State (21-4, 5-0 ACC) took both games of a double-header with ACC foe North Carolina (16-9, 0-2 ACC) by scores of 2-1 and 7-1 to extend its' winning streak to 13 games.

The Seminoles edged North Carolina 2-1 in the first seven-inning game of today's double-header as second baseman Scott Zech drove in J.D. Drew for the game-winning run in the sixth inning of the ACC match-up at Boshamer Stadium in Chapel Hill, N.C.

Drew doubled with one out in the sixth inning to extend his hitting streak to 13 games and scored on Zech's two-out base hit to left centerfield. Zech improved his hitting streak to six games, and has driven in a run in 11 of FSU's last 12 games.

Sophomore left-hander Randy Choate (7-1) picked up the win with his first complete game of the season. Choate allowed one run on five hits and struck out three Tar Heel batters.

North Carolina starter A.Y. Yoder (4-2) gave up two runs on five hits, while striking out three for the loss.

Catcher Jeremy Salazar doubled to right center to begin the third inning and scored after advancing on sacrifice bunts by Billy Brown and first baseman Matt Woodward.

North Carolina knotted the game at 1-1 in the fourth inning with two doubles by Mitch Jones and Brian Whitlock. Jones scored on Whitlock's two-bagger to leftfield.

FSU junior right-hander Chuck Howell led the Seminoles to their second win of the day with a 7-1 complete-game victory over the Tar Heels. Howell gave up one run on six hits and struck out four on the day as he pitched 6.1 innings of shutout ball against the Tar Heels.

Florida State was led by leftfielder Jeremy Morris who started FSU's scoring with a two-out double to left center that scored J.D. Drew. Morris improved his ACC-leading double count to 17 on the year.

First baseman Geoff Sprague went 2-for-3 on the day, driving in Morris on a base hit in the fourth inning. Sprague now has at least two hits in his last three games.
