FLORIDA STATE DOWNS GEORGIA TECH, 16-4, IN BASEBALL SALAZAR HITS FOR CYCLE

APRIL 26, 1996

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- Catcher Jeremy Salazar hit for the cycle and collected a career-high eight RBI, which included a grand slam home run, as he led No. 4 Florida State (38-8, 16-0 ACC) to a 16-4 victory over No. 18 Georgia Tech (28-16, 8-8 ACC).

It was the first time a Florida State player hit for the cycle since Luis Alicea accomplished the feat against Southern Miss in February, 1985.

Salazar belted a three-run double in the first inning as he helped the Seminoles to a 5-0 advantage. The Lafayette, La., native tripled with empty bases in the third inning, before hitting his first career grand slam in the fourth to put FSU up 11-0. Salazar then contributed an RBI-single in the sixth to complete the cycle. His grand slam is the seventh on the season for Florida State which ties a team record set by the 1984 squad.

FSU leftfielder Jeremy Morris hit a two-run double for his 27th of the season, one shy of tying the ACC record for doubles in a season. Morris also homered in the third inning for his eighth of the season.

Left-hander Randy Choate (12-2) shutout the Yellow Jackets for five innings before giving a pair of runs in the sixth and seventh. Choate allowed a total of four runs on six hits and struck out nine batters in 7.0 innings.

Georgia Tech's Chuck Crowder picked up the loss for Tech as he gave up 11 runs on 10 hits and four walks while striking out seven in four innings. It was the most runs given up by a Georgia Tech pitcher during the season.

FSU third baseman Adam Faurot hit his first home run since February with a two-run shot in the first inning. Tech rightfielder Mark Fischer homered in the seventh to drive in two runs for the Yellow Jackets.

Florida State has won 16 consecutive ACC games, one win shy of tying the ACC's best start record, set by Clemson in 1988.
