FLORIDA ATLANTIC OVER POWERS NO. 2 FLORIDA STATE, 13-5

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- Florida Atlantic belted 12 hits, including three home runs, as the Owls defeated No. 2 Florida State, 13-5, in front of 1,103 fans at Dick Howser Stadium breaking the Seminoles seven-game winning streak.

The loss broke a streak of 46 wins over unranked, non-ACC opponents. The last time FSU lost to an unranked, non-ACC opponent was on Feb. 21, 1995, to Winthrop.

Designated-hitter Brennan Hervey started it off for the Owls with a two-run home run in the first inning off FSU starter John Bentley. The Owls went on to score four runs in the second inning off four basehits and two walks.

Bentley (1-1) took the loss for FSU as he gave up six runs on five hits and two walks in one inning pitched.

Righthander Casey Furman (3-0) struck out four batters in 5 2/3 innings for the win. Furman gave up four runs on six hits and four walks.

FAU centerfielder Billy Brown, a former FSU player, went 3-for-6 with two RBI and a solo home run in the fourth inning. Catcher Anthony Doudt contributed a three-run home run in the seventh inning to FAU's campaign.

Rightfielder Terry Henderson had two hits, including a triple, for FSU, and leftfielder Jeremy Morris added a solo home run in the third inning. J.D. Drew drove in two runs on a sacrifice fly and basehit.


