ATLANTA -- Randy Choate scattered nine hits over seven innings, and Scott Zech had three hits and two RBI as ninth-ranked Florida State defeated No. 13 Georgia Tech, 11-6, in ACC baseball Saturday night at Russ Chandler Stadium.\

The Seminoles (33-12, 12-5) moved to within a game and a half of the first-place Yellow Jackets (33-8, 11-3), who have dropped three straight conference games after winning their first 11.\

Tech took a 3-0 lead in the first inning on consecutive doubles by J.J. Thomas and Heath Honeycutt against Choate (10-2), who settled down from there to strike out six and give up just one more run, Jay Hood's fifth-inning homer.\

FSU tied the game at 3-3 in the second when Geoff Sprague doubled and scored on a wild pitch, and Zech singled home a pair of runs.\

The Seminoles took the lead for good with four runs in the fourth on Brooks Badeaux's two-run single, a bases loaded walk and an error. Shawn McCorkel added a two-run double in the eighth for a 9-4 lead, and two more FSU runs scored in the ninth with the aid of three walks and a wild pitch.\

Mark Fischer completed the scoring with a two-run homer, his 15th, in the ninth.\

Jase Wrigley (5-3) got the loss after giving up five runs on five hits in just three innings. Three Tech pitchers issued a total of 13 walks.\

The teams conclude the three-game series at 7 p.m. Sunday.\
