DREW EXTENDS STREAK AS FLORIDA STATE DEFEATS MARYLAND, 13-3

COLLEGE PARK, MD -- Centerfielder J.D. Drew belted three hits, including two home runs, to extend his hitting streak to a school record 28 games as No. 6 Florida State (36-13, 15-6 ACC) defeated Maryland (19-24, 5-16 ACC) at Shipley Field.

Drew's solo home run in the second inning allowed him to tie Brad Parker's FSU record 28-game hitting streak set in 1988. The junior drove in three RBI on three hits on the day and totalled five home runs in the series against the Terrapins.

Florida State lefthander Zach Diaz (3-4) earned the win in relief of Chris Chavez as he shut down the Terrapins for 5 2/3 innings. Diaz struck out six batters and gave up only three hits in the victory. Chavez left the game in the third inning after surrendering up three runs on four hits and six walks. In the second inning, Chavez loaded the bases and walked in two of Maryland's runs.

The Seminoles scored four runs on five hits in the first inning, highlighted by leftfielder Jeremy Morris' RBI-triple. Drew's home run in the second inning gave FSU a 5-0 lead before Chavez walked in two runs in the bottem of the innings. Maryland cut FSU's lead to 5-3 as designated-hitter Brian Barton scored on an RBI-single by centerfielder Eric Beer.

Morris blasted three hits for the Seminoles, including a double and a triple as he knocked in one run on the day. Shortstop Brooks Badeaux also contributed three hits to the Seminoles offense.

Maryland righthander Mike Wooden (2-7) gave up nine runs on 13 hits in 5 2/3 innings in the loss for Maryland.


