FLORIDA STATE DEFEATS NORTH CAROLINA, 8-5, IN ACC BASEBALL

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- Righthander Randy Niles struck out a career-high 11 batters as he led Florida State to a 8-5 victory over North Carolina in front of 2,452 fans at Dick Howser Stadium.

Niles (5-4) allowed five runs on 10 hits in eight innings in the win for the Seminoles.

North Carolina (27-28, 6-17 ACC) jumped out to a 2-0 lead in the first inning as Chris LaMarsh scored on a Julian Dean RBI-single and Brian Roberts stole home.

Florida State (40-15, 17-6 ACC) tied the score in the second inning sparked by a solo home run by catcher Jeremy Salazar. Salazar finished the game with two hits and two RBI.

First baseman Geoff Sprague drove in centerfielder J.D. Drew on a single to centerfield for the game-winning run in the fourth inning. Sprague also added a RBI on a sacrafice fly in the third inning to give FSU a 3-2 advantage.

Drew extended his hitting streak to 34 games with a single to leftfield in the first inning.

Lefthander Scott McAllister (3-4) gave up eight runs on 11 hits in four innings as he took the loss for the Tar Heels.

North Carolina's Rodney Nye hit a solo home run in the fourth inning highlighting a three-run inning for the Tar Heels.

FSU's Zach Diaz picked up his second save of the season as he pitched the ninth inning.
