MORRIS TURNS IN RECORD-BREAKING NIGHT AS FSU DEFEATS NORTH CAROLINA, 11-6, IN ACC BASEBALL

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- Third baseman Geoff Sprague ripped a two-run basehit to centerfield in the seventh inning to lead the Seminoles in a five-run rally as Florida State (41-15, 18-6 ACC) defeated North Carolina (27-29, 6-18 ACC), 11-6, in front of 2,232 fans at Dick Howser Stadium.

Florida State jumped out to a 2-0 lead as leftfielder Jeremy Morris hit a two-run home run in the first inning to drive in shortstop Brooks Badeaux. Morris hit a second home run in the eighth inning for his 21st of the season. With four RBI on the night, Morris set a new ACC all-time RBI record with 254 in his career.

Righthander Chris Chavez gave up four runs on seven hits in 5 1/3 innings for Seminoles. Chuck Howell (7-1) pitched 1.2 innings as he picked up the win for Florida State. Zach Diaz earned his third save of the season for FSU.

North Carolina's Paul Poplin (4-5) took the loss for the Tar Heels as he gave up seven runs on 10 hits.

The Seminoles extended their lead to 4-0 in the second inning as FSU belted four consecutive hits starting with Terry Henderson's double. Designated-hitter Henry Mayfield drove in Henderson on a basehit to rightfield and Mayfield scored on a single by Badeaux.

North Carolina scored three runs in the fourth inning as rightfielder Mike Bynum reached on a error and leftfielder Richie Grimsley blasted a two-run homer. Third baseman Justin Raniszeski walked, advanced on a double by Jay Madeira and scored on a sacrafice bunt by second baseman Jeremy Sessoms.

The Tar Heels tied the game at four in the fifth inning as Rodney Nye scored on an RBI-single by Grimsley. Nye and Grimsley hit two solo home runs in the seventh inning of reliever Chuck Howell to take a 6-4 lead.

FSU centerfielder J.D. Drew ended his hitting streak at 34 games.
