NO. 1 FLORIDA STATE DOWNS NO. 3 NORTH CAROLINA, 12-6

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- Designated-hitter Sam Scott drove in three runs on two hits, including a two-run home run, to lead No. 1 Florida State (27-3, 7-0 ACC) to a 12-6 win over No. 3 North Carolina (22-3, 2-2 ACC) in front of 3,155 fans at Dick Howser Stadium.

Right-hander Jon McDonald (5-1) fanned nine batters in 6 1/3 innings pitched as he recorded the win for FSU. McDonald scattered six hits and gave up six runs, four of

which were earned, in the outing.

Florida State chased right-hander Kyle Snyder (6-2) after five innings. Snyder surrendered 11 runs on seven hits and five walks despite striking out nine batters in the outing. Snyder took his second loss in as many weeks after racking up a 6-0 record to start

the season. It was his shortest appearance of the year.

North Carolina jumped out to a 2-0 lead with back-to-back doubles by second baseman Chris LaMarsh and centerfielder Jarrett Shearin in the first inning. The Seminoles bounced right back in the bottom of the inning with a solo homer by second baseman Marshall McDougall and a two-run shot to right field by Scott to give Florida State a 3-2 edge. McDougall increased his hitting streak to 21 games with the homer.

The Seminoles added to their lead in the second as catcher Jeremiah Klosterman led off with a single to right field and scored on a sacrifice fly by McDougall. Klosterman extended his hitting streak to 14 games with the basehit and ended the day with three hits. Leftfielder Chris Smith reach base on a walk and came home on a single by rightfielder Matt Diaz for FSU's second run of the inning.

Shortstop Brett Groves led off the fourth inning with a bunt basehit and scored on a

fielding miscue of Smith's sacrifice bunt attempt to give FSU a 6-2 advantage.

Florida State broke the game open scoring five runs in the fifth inning with help from Klosterman's RBI-double, an RBI-basehit by Groves and a pair of Tar Heel errors.

First baseman John Halliday was 3-for-4 on the day. Seminole reliever Chris Whidden struck out five batters in 2 2/3 innings pitched.
