McDOUGALL, NO. 2 FSU RALLY TO DEFEAT NC STATE 6-5 IN 12 INNINGS

Tallahassee, FL – Marshall McDougall made it a memorable Senior Day at Dick Howser Stadium as he doubled home two runs in the bottom of the 12th inning to lead No. 2 Florida State (41-9, 13-5 ACC) to a 6-5 victory over NC State (27-24, 9-12 ACC) in front of 2,409 fans. McDougall tied a school record with four doubles in the game, finishing 4-for-5 with three RBI. His two-out double off the screen with two aboard gave FSU its seventh win its final at bat this year.

FSU took a 1-0 lead after one inning of play when Chris Smith led off with a single, advanced to second on John-Ford Griffin's walk, and scored on a McDougall double to right center.

The Seminoles upped their lead to 4-0 in the bottom of the fourth. Griffin singled, McDougall reached on an error and Ryan Barthelemy walked to load the bases with no one out. Brett Groves forced in a run when he was hit by a pitch and John Halliday knocked in another with a sacrifice fly. Barthelemy scored the third run of the inning on a throwing error by NC State catcher Dan Mooney.

The Wolfpack picked up a run in the seventh to make it 4-1 when Jason Smith doubled home Mike Prochaska.

NC State tied the game up with three more runs in the top of the eighth. Josh Schmitt came through with a bases loaded, pinch-hit single to knock in two runs with the third run scoring when Mooney singled home Prochaska.

In the top of the 12th inning, NC State took its first lead of the game when Brian Wright hit a solo home run over the right field fence.

With two outs in the bottom half of the 12th inning, Smith singled to right and Griffin drew his second walk of the game to set the table for McDougall. On a 3-2 pitch, the senior third baseman ripped a double off the top of the screen in right center to score Smith and Griffin.

FSU starter Jon McDonald (9-2) gave up just one earned run in 6.2 innings of work in the no-decision. Matt Lynch (6-0) recorded the final two outs with a pair of strikeouts in the top of the 12th inning to pick up the win in relief.

Schmitt took the loss for the Wolfpack, giving up the final two runs in 2.1 innings of work.

McDougall and Smith, who finished the day 3-for-5 with two runs scored, were the only two Seminoles to have more than one base hit. McDougall went 7-for-13 in the three-game series with two home runs and five doubles.

FSU next travels to Clemson for a key ACC series (Saturday-Monday) before concluding the regular season at North Carolina.
