## FLORIDA STATE DOWNS APPALACHIAN STATE, 7-4 IN SEVEN INNINGS

Tallahassee, Fla. – No. 19 Florida State (6-5) completed a two-game sweep of Appalachian State (1-9) with a rain-shortened 7-4 victory in front of 839 fans at Dick Howser Stadium. Marc LaMacchia earned the win in his first career start, going six innings and allowing one earned run on four hits. LaMacchia struck out seven and walked just two in the seven inning contest.

In the bottom of the second, Bryan Zech and Brett Groves were both hit by pitches to start the inning. After Scott Toole moved Zech to third with a fielder's choice, freshman Tony Richie connected on a single up the middle to give the Seminoles a 1-0 lead.

The visiting Mountaineers drew even at one apiece in the third, when Chris Downard knocked in Wes Timmons with an RBI-double.

The Seminoles jumped back on top in the bottom of the third. After Ryan Barthelemy led off the inning with a double, Chris Cole drew a walk and Bryan Zech singled to load the bases. Brett Groves followed with a two-run double and Scott Toole made it 4-1 with a run scoring groundout.

ASU tied it back up in the top of the fourth, taking advantage of two Seminole errors in the inning. Marko Little scored a run on an error and Carey Hobbs hit a two-run single.

FSU added single runs in the fifth, sixth and seventh for the final margin of 7-4. Karl Jernigan's RBI-groundout to score Zech was the game-winner. Jernigan also added an RBI-double in the seventh.

Reliever Daniel Hodges held the Mountaineers scoreless in the top of the seventh for his first save of the season. Jernigan, Barthelemy, Zech and Richie had multi-hit days for FSU.

The Seminoles departed Dick Howser Stadium immediately after the game for Melbourne, where they will take on the Florida Marlins in a Thursday afternoon exhibition game. First pitch is scheduled for 1:05 at Florida's spring training facility. The game will be carried live on SportsRadio 1270 in Tallahassee and can also be picked up on the internet at <a href="https://www.seminoles.com">www.wnls.com</a>. FSU returns to Dick Howser for a three-game series with Michigan State on Friday (6:00 p.m.), Saturday (2:00 p.m.) and Sunday (1:00 p.m.).
