NO. 10 FLORIDA STATE COMPLETES SWEEP OF MARYLAND, 13-1 Home runs by Barthelemy, Futrell, Griffin and Rogers Pace Seminoles Offensively

College Park, Md. – The No. 10 Florida State Seminoles (38-14, 18-3 ACC), who clinched the ACC regular season title Saturday night, completed a three-game sweep of Maryland (15-34, 4-19 ACC) by a score of 13-1 at Shipley Field. Ryan Barthelemy, John-Ford Griffin and Mike Futrell each had three hits and a home run to lead FSU at the plate. Robby Read (7-4) was the winner after going five innings and allowing one earned run on six hits. Read struck out seven and walked five.

The Seminoles, who did not trail all weekend, once again took the early lead with two runs in the top of the second inning. Futrell doubled and came around to score on a double down the left field line by Karl Jernigan. Jeff Probst's single put runners on the corners and Jernigan scored on Bryan Zech's sacrifice fly to left.

FSU added three more runs in the top of the third to make it 5-0. Griffin doubled, Barthelemy singled and Futrell drew a walk to load the bases. Nick Rogers then knocked in Griffin with a sacrifice fly to left. After Jernigan walked to load the bases again, Probst picked up an easy RBI with the third walk of the inning. Zech knocked in run number three with a fielder's choice groundout.

The Terps avoided the shutout in the bottom of the fourth when John McCurdy hit a solo home run over the left field fence.

Rogers pushed the FSU lead back to five with a solo home run to left in the fifth inning, his second of the weekend.

In the top of the sixth, Griffin and Futrell got into the home run derby with solo shots to extend the Tribe's lead to 8-1.

The Seminoles made it 10-1 in the eighth on run-scoring singles by Barthelemy and Futrell.

Barthelemy's three-run home run in the top of the ninth was his third in the last two games and gave FSU a 13-1 lead.

The Seminoles conclude the regular season this weekend at Duke before heading to the ACC Tournament.
