Gill Leads the Noles at the NCAA Cross Country National Championships

The women finished 18th, up ten spots from last year while the men took 29th in their first trip since 1981.

Tallahassee - The Florida State women's cross country team enjoyed the fruits of their labor, getting back to the NCAA National Championships and improving from last year's 28th place finish to 18th this time around. The Noles ran in un-Florida like weather with the temperature holding steady at minus three degrees with the wind chill at the 11:00 a.m. men's start. The meet was hosted by the University of Northern Iowa in Cedar Falls.

"Our ladies ran fantastic for it to be minus three degrees at the start of the race. We picked up some big wins beating Wake Forest for the first time as well as Duke in the conference. We also beat Tennessee, who finished ahead of us (in first place) at the regionals. We finished very well being the third ACC team to cross the finish line and the first in the South Region," said head coach Bob Braman.

The women's team was led by senior Vicky Gill, who finished eleventh overall in a time of 20:08.5 - up from last year's 35th place finish - and junior Natalie Hughes, who placed 34th in a time of 20:50.1, both earning All-America honors for the 2003 cross country season. The Garnet and Gold finished 18th overall with 455 points. Last year, the women made their first trip to nationals finishing 28th out of 31 teams. This year, behind Gill and Hughes, senior Helen Hofstede completed the race in a time of 21:20.3 which was good for 89th place, junior Rachel Marsh ran another personal best time of 21:58 to place 156th followed by junior Anne Clinton who finished in 165th place at 22:06.1. Marsh's prior personal best time was set last week at the NCAA South Regionals. The Orlando, Fla. native's time helped the women earn the automatic bid to Iowa.

"Vicky moved up while Natalie ran the best cross country of her life. Helen ran a personal best by 28 seconds to finish 115th and Rachel, after setting a personal best last time out - set another one again. Rachel put us in last week's race and here she did it again. Anne was right behind her and she did especially well after almost getting run over at the start," said Braman.

The men were led by freshman Luke Beevor with a place of 100th and a time of 31:04.8 followed by junior Eddie Rodriguez in 130th place in 31:24.6. Junior Ian Hornabrook (151st - 31:36.4), freshman Tom Lancashire (161st - 31:43.7) and sophomore Kevin Cook (191st - 32:24.3) Junior Joep Tigchelaar was disqualified for running outside of the course.

"With Joep, there was a big controversy because less than two miles out, he was pushed off the course and couldn't get back in so he ran next to the course. Luke had the best day for us because he ran really well despite his injury. For two weeks, he hasn't really had a full workout so he toughed it out for us. Eddy ran awesome and did a really nice job for a kid from Miami as did Kevin (Cook) who's never seen snow before. Ian also handled the rough course well. More importantly, the guys ran as hard as they have all year. We tried to adapt to the weather but obviously were physically at a huge deficit," said Braman.

UNC's Shalane Flanagan defended her national title completing the 6K course in 19:30.4. Stanford took the team titles in both the men's and women's races while Colorado's Dathan Ritzenhein won the 10K race in 29:14.1.

FSU LEAVES FOR NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

The No. 23 men's and No. 30 women's cross country teams head to Cedar Falls, Iowa to race on Saturday at 11:00 am and 12:15 pm, respectively.

Tallahassee, Fla. - For the first time in school history, the Florida State men's and women's cross country teams will go to the NCAA National Championships. Both teams earned an automatic bid after placing second in the South Regional Championship hosted by Auburn University on November 15. The men's team finished behind the University of Georgia with 64 points with five of the Seminole men finishing in the top 20. The women's team crossed the line just behind the University of Tennessee. A first place finish by senior Vicky Gill fueled their 93-point effort.

Gill has torched the cross country scene in the three seasons she's donned the Garnet and Gold. Arguably the best female cross country runner in Florida State history, she became the first Seminole women's cross country member to achieve All-American status when she finished 15th overall at the 2002 NCAA National Championships. Her fifteenth place finish was the highest for any Seminole at a national championship. Among Gill's other honors are two-time NCAA South Region Athlete of the Year, three-time All-ACC honoree and three-time All-South Region performer. In addition to winning back-to-back NCAA South Region Championships, Gill won the 2002 NCAA Pre-Nationals meet. The Lancashire, England native earned her final year of eligibility back twelve minutes before the Great American Cross Country Festival Meet where she finished second overall. Gill owns five of the top ten all-time 6K finishes in FSU history, the most by any current or former Nole.

Junior Joep Tigchelaar has led the men's surge finishing second overall and crossing the tape first for the Tribe in four of five meets this season. Tigchelaar has been a strong force for FSU since his freshman year. One of only two Noles from last year's top seven still running this year, he has set the pace for FSU runners this season. This year he was awarded with his third All-ACC team honors and third NCAA All-South Region honors. In his sophomore season, he finished sixth overall at the ACC Championships meet, placed fifth in the NCAA South Regionals and earned a spot at nationals. He was named ACC Freshman of the Year in addition to earning a spot on the All-ACC team in 2001.

Both teams will be making their second championship appearance with the women earning a spot after last year's second place South Region finish while the men will make first since 1981. That team was led by All-American Herb Wills aside Larry Greene and Doug Overfelt. Wills finished 16th overall in the NCAA National Championship meet while Greene finished 56th overall. After that season, six of eight guys were lost to graduation.

The NCAA Cross Country National Championships will be held at the Byrnes Park/Irv Warren Memorial Golf Course in Waterloo, Iowa. The top two teams from all nine regions earn automatic bids with 13 teams selected at large in addition to 38 individuals to round out the 255 competitors racing. Last year's team champion was on the women's side was BYU with UNC's Shalane Flanagan winning the individual title. On the men's side, Colorado's Jorge Torres won the individual title and Stanford won as a team.


The Noles will race on Monday, November 24, 2003 with the men's race kicking off at 11:00 a.m. and the women following at 12:15 a.m.

Tallahassee - After a historical performance at the ACC Championships two weeks ago, the FSU men's and women's cross country teams will head to Auburn to face NCAA South Region opponents.

CLOSE TO THE EDGE – At the ACC Cross Country Championships, held in Winston-Salem, N.C., the Noles finished at the top of FSU school history and on the edge of current champions. The men set a school record for highest finish in an ACC Conference Championship with a second place mark (66 points), behind perennial champion N.C. State. The women finished fifth, tying their highest placing since 1992. Senior Vicky Gill led the Noles crossing the line second on the heels of defending cross country national champion UNC's Shalane Flanagan.

KNOW YOUR (SOUH REGIONALS) HISTORY – In the history of the South Regionals, Florida State has steadily grown into a winning program since first competing in 1998. The Noles began with a ninth place finish on the men's side and 13th place finish on the women's side. Their highest finish was third in 2001 for the men and last year's second place finish topped all prior years for the women, both feats coming under the 2003 ACC Conference Coach of the Year, FSU's Bob Braman.

THREE'S THE MAGIC NUMBER – For Florida State, three's the lucky number – three harriers made All-ACC, two for a third time plus one for this third overall title. Juniors Joep Tigchelaar, Ian Hornabrook and senior Vicky Gill were selected to the All-ACC team for the 2003 Cross Country season. Tigchelaar earned a spot on the team for the third time in as many years after finishing fourth overall. Hornabrook finished eighth overall and ran a personal best time at the meet to earn his first nod on the team. The Rend Lake College transfer, in his first season at FSU, previously won two NJCAA DII Cross Country Championships (2001 & 2002). On the women's side, senior Vicky Gill, not only medalled but was the only Nole on the All-ACC team for the women. Gill, who placed 2nd in the race, finished second last year, 31 seconds behind this season's time of 19:49.5. The Lancashire, England native made the All-ACC team for the third time.

THIS TIME LAST YEAR - The Seminole men followed a fifth place finish at the ACC Championships with a fourth place showing this time last year at the NCAA South Regional Championships in Knoxville, Tenn., narrowly missing an automatic bid to the NCAA National Championships. Then sophomore Joep Tigchelaar, who earned an automatic individual bid to the nationals with a time of 32:22.7, led the Noles through the 10K course finishing seventh overall. The FSU women finished second overall, their highest since the beginning of South Region competition in 1998, earning one of two automatic bids to the NCAA National Championship in Terra Haute, Ind. Leading the Noles to their first ever national Championship appearance was then senior Vicky Gill, who crossed the tape 15th overall out of 254 runners in a time of 20:07. Gill was also awarded All-American honors for her season.
