CONDENSED RULES FOR RECORDING FOOTBALL STATISTICS*

[For Mama Tuam]

(Originated by the N.C.A.A. Football Rules Committee's Sub-committee on Football Statistics)

(Continued from back of form 347-A)

SECTION 6-PUNTS.

Article 1: Punts are measured from the line of scrimmage to the point of ultimate advance, if the ball remains in the field of play or goes out of bounds. (Note — "Ultimate advance" is the point where ball goes out of bounds, is downed, or is recovered by the defense.

(Note — "Ultimate advance" of the punt shall be construed to include also any distance which a receiver of the punt may retreat toward his own goal before attempting to return up field. This interpretation gives greatest benefit to both the punter and the receiver, since excellence of the punt normally is responsible for retreat by the receiver. Thus "minus yards" should NOT be recorded under "punt returns.")

Article 2: When a punt goes over the goal line (a touchback), distance of the punt is measured from the line of scrimmage to the 20-yard line only, since this is the limit of the punt's value to the kicking team.

Article 3: If a receiver muffs a punt and the ball continues toward his goal line, the punt is measured to the point of recovery or ultimate advance, as defined above. If a receiver muffs a punt and the ball bounds back toward the kicker's goal, the punt is measured to the point of the muff (the point of ultimate advance), and the receiver is credited with a punt return and with the yards from the point of the muff to the point of recovery, regardless of which team recovers.

Article 4: A blocked punt is recorded as a "team" entry, and not charged against the individual kicker. Thus, in the case of a blocked punt which does not pass the line of scrimmage, enter the word "team" in lieu of kicker's name and charge one punt for NO yards, so the blocked punt is included under "Times Kicked" in team totals.

If the ball travels toward the kicker's goal and is recovered by the blocking team, the yardage is treated as a punt return by the player who blocked the kick. If the ball travels toward the kicker's goal and is recovered by the kicking team, the yardage is treated as a punt return by the player who blocked the kick—and the blocking team is charged with a fumble lost, except on fourth down.

SECTION 7 - KICK RETURNS.

Article 1: Only the number of punts and kickoffs which the receiving team actually attempts to return are included under kick returns.

(Exception — Blocked kicks which travel toward the kicker's goal. See Article 4 of Section 6.)

Article 2: The return will be measured from the point where the returning player actually gains control of the ball to the point where the ball is declared dead, or is lost by fumble. There are no "minus yards" under kick returns (see note under Article 1 of Section 6).

Article 3: The return of an attempted field goal, which falls short and is returned by the defending team, is treated as a punt return.

SECTION 8 - FREE KICKS.

Free kicks are recorded as kickoffs if made from placement, and as punts if the ball is punted. The receiving player is credited with a kickoff return, or a punt return, respectively.

SECTION 9-GOALS FROM THE FIELD.

For the sake of uniformity in an area where considerable disagreement has existed, it is recommended that all news story and record reference to a successful field goal cite the yard line from which kicked, rather than the distance kicked, i.e., "field goal from 25-yard line," rather than "25-yard field goal."

Field goals are not recorded under punting.

SECTION 10-POINTS AFTER TOUCHDOWN.

Article 1: A player attempting a try-for-point-after-touchdown by kicking is not charged with an attempt when a bad pass from center or a fumble by the ball holder, precludes an opportunity to kick. Such an unsuccessful attempt is charged to the "team," rather than to any individual player. However, if the ball is momentarily fumbled and then kicked, an attempt is charged to the individual kicker, regardless of the success or failure of the effort.

Article 2: The try-for-point-after-touchdown is made while time is out and is not recorded as a play from scrimmage (rush, pass or kick).

When a try-for-point-after-touchdown is by forward passing, the passer is charged (under SCORING) with the attempt. If successful, the receiver is credited under SCORING with the conversion and points scored, and the passer is credited with a conversion under FORWARD PASSING.

SECTION 11 - SAFETIES.

No individual credit is recorded for any player on either team when a safety is scored. The team benefitting from the score is credited.

SECTION 12 - FUMBLES.

On any play terminated by a fumble, the yards involved to the point of recovery are credited or charged to the player who fumbled, regardless of which team recovers the fumble.

(Approved Ruling — On rushing play, ball carrier of Team A fumbles at the line of scrimmage and the ball travels 5 yards toward Team B goal line, before it is recovered by Team B. Player of Team A who fumbled is credited with rushing gain of 5 yards and Team A is charged with a fumble lost.)

Fred Pickard, a 160-pound "bruiser" from Columbia. Tenn., powered the Florida State Seminoles to a 10-0 upset over Tennessee yesterday, the school's first victory over an SEC team.

The junior speedster, No. 10 ground gainer in the country, struck the listless Vols a mighty blow in the mid-section with a 51-yard run in the third quarter that led to the Vols' third defeat of the year.

Pickard took a handoff from quarterback Vic Prinzi, operating in the razzle-dazzle I-formation, powered through the center own 40 and headed goalward.

of the Vol line on the third play own 40 and headed goalward, of the third period.

Fullback Carl Smith caught him,

Churning and turning as he however, at the Vol 31.

This jaunt got the Seminoles out of a hole and put the Vols on the run for good. The Seminoles drove to a first down at the 9.

Led by linebackers Ray Brann and Ken Sadler, the Vol. defenders dug in and held the Seminoles. Coach Tom Nugent sent senior John Sheppard in to attempt a field goal. Prinzi put the ball down on the Tennessee 16 and



Sheppard punched it over up-rights for the 3-0 lead.

The Seminoles got their touchdown less than three minutes

After the Vols had lost three yards on two plays, guard Al Ulmer intercepted a George Wright pass on the Tennessee 38 and returned it 10 yards. Wright knocked him out of bounds.

Prinzi, a ball-handling magician, faked to Pickard as he peeled off the I, faded back and fired a pass to end Tony Romeo at the 15. Romeo, a soph-

omore, ran to the Tennessee I before Bobby Sandlin caught him.

Halfback Bobby Renn went through the middle to score and Sheppard kicked the extra point, giving FSU its 10-0 margin.

Pickard and Prinzi were the big guns in the Seminole camp, but they received tremendous support from a band of ferocious linemen.

End Pete Fleming, tackles Bob Swoszowski, Bill Brown and John Spivey and guards Ulmer, Jerry Graham and Leo Baggett did most of the damage to the Vol interior. The tackles moved in to the guard position on offense to clear the way for Pickard & Co.

Tennessee lost sophomore tail-back Bill Majors in the first quarter, the second time the Vols had the ball. He collided with teammate Joe Schaffer just as Baggett and Ron Hinson hit the Vol tailback for a two-yard loss at the Tennessee 36.

Majors received a rib injury and didn't return. His brother, Joe, the No. 2 FSU quarterback. was in the game at salety at the time. They were on the field together only five plays.

Joe gained 18 yards on six carries for the Seminoles and completed one out of six passes for 11 yards.

Tennessee got the first break of the game early in the first quarter but was unable to take advantage of it. Renn punted straight up, the ball going out of bounds on the FSU 41, a yard behind the line of scrimmage.

Bill Majors got six and Smith picked up five on a fullback reverse to the FSU 30. After Majors gained 4, Smith bulled nine yards to the 17 for another first. Majors went off left tackle to the 13 but the Vols were holding and penalized back to the FSU 29.

Fleming caught Majors as he attempted to pass and dropped

him at the 35. Majors swept end for 13 but on the next play Graham got through and caught Majors for a seven-yard loss at the 29. The Vols were forced to kick.

The Vols rolled again late in the quarter, sparked by a 17-yard pass from Majors to Mike LaSorsa and a 10-yard sweep by Smith. Smith was pulled to the ground by Joe Majors after making a tiest at the FSU 34. Bill Majors was injured on the next play and the drive bogged down at the FSU 29.

Gene Etter and Wright handled the tailback chores the rest of the game. The Vols couldn't penetrate the tough Seminole defense, however, and didn't make a first down in the second and third quarters.

Tommy Potts, back in action for the first time since the Auburn game, came through with a big play to halt FSU's first scoring bid. The Seminoles rolled 34 yards in five plays late in the

second period.

Tennessee sent its first unit back in and on the first play La-Sorsa caught Prinzi for a 10-yard loss back to the Vol 32. Prinzi then fired a long pass intended for Renn. Potts fought off Renn with his injured right hand and intercepted the ball with his left at the Tennessee 27.

FSU got back in Vol territory just before the half ended with Joe Majors directing the team. Majors passed to Renn for 11 yards and a first down at the Vol 27 with 20 seconds remaining. Ken Kestner attempted a field goal, with Majors holding on the 33, but it fizzled off to the left.

The Seminoles took the secondhalf kickoff and didn't slow down until they had 10 points. They came close to a second TD, moving to the Vol 13 for a first down. Reserve center Tom Husband stopped this march, intercepting Joe Majors' first-down pass at the Tennessee 6.

FSU got the hall on the Tennessee 38 just before the third period ended on an unusual play.

Renn punted from his own 42 to Etter on the Vol 29. Blocking back Jim Cartwright was detected clipping, however, at the Vol 38 while the punt was in the air. The penalty is loss of the ball at the point of the foul, Tennessee got the ball back one play later when Joe Lukowski recovered Renn's fumble at the Vol 37.

Tennessee gambled on fourth down and a foot to go early in the fourth to give the visitors a first on the Vol 29. Smith fumbled a low snap from center but recovered a yard short of a first down.

After three plays netted only five yards, Sheppard was sent in again with his kicking tee. The hall was snapped to the kicker, thowever, and he fired a pass to

the Vol 2 intended for Romeo. The Vols broke it up and took over on the 24.

Tennessee then launched its best offensive push of the game, relling 61 yards to the FSU 15 before having a pass intercepted.

Etter fired a 13-yard pass to Armstrong to start the drive. It was the first Vol first down of the half. On third down Neyle Sollee sped through right guard for 16 yards to the FSU 42, longest Vol run of the season from scrimmage.

Etter took to the air again two plays later, throwing 18 yards to LaSorsa. Two plays lost 3 yards back to the 30 and Etter spotted Armstrong a g a i n, firing a 12-yarder, just short of a first down. Sollee smashed over center to the 15 and on first down Prinzi intercepted Etter's pass at the FSU 2 and returned it 32 yards.

THE PLAY of guard Wayne Grubb, the tackles, Bo Shafer and Joe Schaffer, ends Potts, Armstrong and LaSorsa, line-backers Sadler and Brann and defensive backs Smith, Don Stephens and Sandlin kept the Seminoles from turning the game into a rout.

FSU USED TTS heralded I-formation about 80 per cent of the time. The Seminoles resorted to the split-T and tight-T only briefly.
