BILL PETERSON

Head Football Coach

Florida State University begins a new era of football in 1960 under the leadership of 40-year-old Bill Peterson, one of the most personable young head coaches in the game.

A former offensive line coach at Louisiana State University, Peterson was the highly-popular choice of Florida State officials and fans to become the Seminoles' fifth modern-day head football coach last Dec. 7.

He has continued to impress Sunshine State football fans from Pensacola to Miami in scores of banquet appearances since his arrival in Tallahassee.

Peterson, a sincere, straight-shooting person who bears a striking resemblance to television's Gene Barry (Bat Masterson), has been associated with success throughout his coaching career.

Following his 1946 graduation from Ohio Northern University, where he was a standout end, he was a successful high school coach for 10 years in Ohio. His teams at Forest, Wapakoneta, and Mansfield, O., sported a combined won-lost record of 51-22-3. Two of his Mansfield elevens won Ohio state high school championships.

In 1955, Peterson was the only assistant coach that LSU's Paul Dietzel brought with him to the LSU campus. Peterson was credited with obtaining many of the players who boosted Louisiana State into the top ranks of collegiate football. LSU's 1958 team won the national championship and defeated Clemson in the 1959 Sugar Bowl. The 1959 Tigers compiled a 9-1 record and were ranked No. 3 nationally.

A native of Toronto, O., Peterson is active in the Methodist Church. He and his wife, Marjorie, have five sons: Ronnie, 16; Tommy, 11; Johnny, 7; Billy, 4, and David, 1.

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1960 FLORIDA STATE FOOTBALL OUTLOOK

There is a time-worn adage in football that "you can't win with sophomores." Florida State's 1960 roster lists 44 sophomores(out of 68 players), but new Head Coach Bill Peterson refuses to take anything but an optimistic stand.

"We had the finest spring practice I have ever gone through," says Peterson. "We achieved our goal in building morale, installing a new offense, and getting to know our personnel."

Peterson recognizes the Seminoles face one of the greatest schedule challenges in Florida State's 14 years of football. The independent Seminoles in 1960 meet Richmond, Florida, Wake Forest, The Citadel, Mississippi Southern, William and Mary, Kentucky, Miami (Fla.), Houston, and Auburn.

Besides the unveiling of many new faces this fall, the Seminoles will have a new offense. It is an attack that combines features of the winged T and professional-type maneuvers. "We can run a play six or seven different ways. It is flexible enough so we can adapt ourselves to various situations." Seventeen lettermen return, 16 from FSU's injury-troubled 1959 team that won four games and lost six. Halfback Carl Meyer, a 1958 letterman, is back after a year's absence.

Principal losses among 11 departed lettermen are halfback Fred Pickard, FSU's all-time leading rusher; quarterback Joe Majors, who set nine individual passing records; three-time All-Florida guard Al Ulmer, and all-state tackle John Spivey.

Leading returnees are ends Tony Romeo, Jim Daniel, and Fred Grimes; tackle Don Donatelli, guard Steve Klesius (a tackle last season), center Jack Hardy, and halfbacks Bud Whitehead and Jack Espenship (a fullback in '59).

These and other veterans are one key to Seminole plans. The mate to that key rests with sophomores up from last year's undefeated freshman team. Seminole coaches are reserving opinion on them until the returns are in this fall.

The newcomers are inexperienced, but have size. The 1960 Seminoles will be bigger than ever. One starting line combination in the family spring game averaged 216 pounds, quite a change from "lightweight" FSU teams of the past.

The most vital position likely is at quarterback, where only Roy Bickford, No. 2 signal-caller in 1959, returns. Charles Alexander, highly-regarded sophomore from Orange, Tex., has moved in front on a strong, talented passing arm and play-calling savvy. But diminutive Eddie Feely, 5-7, 164-pounder from Gainesville, captured the fancy of the spring-game crowd with dazzling running and slick throwing. Buddy Yarbrough, solid sophomore from Arcadia, figures, too.

The Seminoles are blessed with halfback talent. Senior left half Bud Whitehead led the nation in pass interceptions last season (6 for 111 yards) and was among national leaders in pass receptions (31 for 320 yards). Senior right half Jack Espenship, shifted from fullback, is a devastating runner at 202 pounds. Ken Cone and Carl Meyer have experience and sophomores Happy Fick, Ken Russom and Tom Hillabrand figure to be heard from.

At fullback, Paul Andrews has experience and desire. Doug Williams, transfer from South Georgia, could blossom. Ed Parker, 6-3, 214-pound junior college All-American last year at Coffeerville, Kans., may become an offensive gem.

Up front, much depends on end Tony Romeo, a two-way sensation as a sophomore. Romeo was injured in the 1959 opening game and a knee operation last winter makes him a question mark. Juniors Jim Daniel and Fred Grimes are experienced ends. Newcomer Lamar Lee adds weight (208 pounds) to the flanks and has field-goal kicking talent. Soph Sam Partlow shows punting promise.

There is size at tackle, but only Don Donatelli, Bob Swoszowski, and Joe Verbinski have logged playing time. Marion Bronson, Jessy Odom, and Tom Slicker are sophomores on the way up. Guard may be the biggest trouble spot. Junior Steve Klesius, converted from tackle to guard, and letterman Abner Bigbie represent the only experience. Sophomores John Levings, Jim Sims, Bruce Darsey, and Gene McDowell must come through.

Center appears to be adequate with squadman Don Sellers and lettermen Jack Hardy and Ray Lamb in the fold. Lamb shifted from guard. Leadership from the veterans and improvement of sophomores will be all-important. "If our players have the same desire next fall that they had this spring, we are going to get better with each game," Peterson says.
