# CONDENSED RULES FOR RECORDING FOOTBALL STATISTICS\*

(Originated by the N.C.A.A. Football Rules Committee's Sub-committee on Football Statistics)

(Continued from back of Form 347-A)

### SECTION 6 - PUNTS

Article 1: Punts are measured from the line of scrimmage to the point of ultimate advance, if the ball remains in the field of play or goes out of bounds. (Note — "Ultimate advance" is the point where ball goes out of bounds, is downed, or is recovered by the defense.

(Note — "Ultimate advance" of the punt shall be construed to include also any distance which a receiver of the punt may retreat toward his own goal before attempting to return up field. This interpretation gives greatest benefit to both the punter and the receiver, since excellence of the punt normally is responsible for retreat by the receiver. Thus "minus yards" should NOT be recorded under "punt returns.")

Article 2: When a punt goes over the goal line (a touchback), distance of the punt is measured from the line of scrimmage to the 20-yard line only, since this is the limit of the punt's value to the kicking team.

Article 3: If a receiver muffs a punt and the ball continues toward his goal line, the punt is measured to the point of recovery or ultimate advance, as defined above. If a receiver muffs a punt and the ball bounds back toward the kicker's goal, the punt is measured to the point of the muff (the point of ultimate advance), and the receiver is credited with a punt return and with the yards from the point of the muff to the point of recovery, regardless of which team recovers.

Article 4: A blocked punt is recorded as a "team" entry, and not charged against the individual kicker. Thus, in the case of a blocked punt which does not pass the line of scrimmage, enter the word "team" in lieu of kicker's name and charge one punt for NO yards, so the blocked punt is included under "Times Kicked" in team totals.

If the ball travels toward the kicker's goal and is recovered by the **blocking** team, the yardage is treated as a punt return by the player who blocked the kick. If the ball travels toward the kicker's goal and is recovered by the **kicking** team, the yardage is treated as a punt return by the player who blocked the kick — and the blocking team is charged with a fumble lost, except on fourth down.

# SECTION 7 - KICK RETURNS.

Article 1: Only the number of punts and kickoffs which the receiving team actually attempts to return are included under kick returns.

(Exception — Blocked kicks which travel toward the kicker's goal. See Article 4 of Section 6.)

Article 2: The return will be measured from the point where the returning player actually gains control of the ball to the point where the ball is declared dead, or is lost by fumble. There are no "minus yards" under kick returns (see note under Article 1 of Section 6).

Article 3: The return of an attempted field goal, which falls short and is returned by the defending team, is treated as a punt return.

### SECTION 8 - FREE KICKS.

See Official Football Statisticians Manual.

### SECTION 9 - GOALS FROM THE FIELD.

Successful goals from the field are measured from the point where the ball is kicked to the goal posts (to the goal line plus ten yards, since the goal posts are ten yards behind the goal line).

The distance of such kicks is recorded on form 347 only under "principal individual plays." If kick is unsuccessful, show yard line from which kicked, in lieu of distance.

### SECTION 10 - POINTS AFTER TOUCHDOWN.

Article 1: A player attempting a try-for-point-after-touchdown by kicking is not charged with an attempt when a bad pass from center or a fumble by the ball holder, precludes on opportunity to kick. Such an unsuccessful attempt is charged to the "team," rather than to any individual player. However, if the ball is momentarily fumbled and then kicked, an attempt is charged to the individual kicker, regardless of the success or failure of the effort.

Article 2: The try-for-point-after-touchdown is made while time is out and is not recorded as a play from scrimmage (rush, pass or kick).

When a try-for-point-after-touchdown is by forward passing, the passer is charged (under SCORING) with the attempt, whether successful or not. If successful, the receiver is credited under SCORING with the conversion and points scored, and the passer is credited with a conversion under FORWARD PASSING.

Such a passing effort is recorded as a PAT attempt and is NOT recorded as a pass attempt or a pass reception.

### SECTION 11 - SAFETIES.

No individual credit is recorded for any player on either team when a safety is scored. The team benefitting from the score is credited.

### SECTION 12 - FUMBLES.

On any play terminated by a fumble, the yards involved to the point of recovery are credited or charged to the player who fumbled, regardless of which team recovers the fumble.

(Approved Ruling — On rushing play, ball carrier of Team A fumbles at the line of scrimmage and the ball travels 5 yards toward Team B goal line, before it is recovered by Team B. Player of Team A who fumbled is credited with rushing gain of 5 yards and Team A is charged with a fumble lost.)



# KENTUCKY vs. FLORIDA STATE

Kentucky 6, Florida State 48.

That's where tonight's battle of Seminoles and Wildcats That was the almost unbelievable outcome of the fourth meeting in a young series which took place in Tallahassee one year ago. The Wildcats, like elephants, sport long memories and the 1964 score will be uppermost in mind as they take the field tonight in search of revenge over FSU and a new lease on life-national-rating-wise.

Ironically, the game shapes up with a strange parallel. Kentucky is faced with the assignment of gaining revenge of its own in the manner that surprisingly-potent Auburn did last week. In a turnabout from the Wildcats' feat of spoiling their national image in 1964 with a 20-0 upset, the Plainsmen slapped Kentucky with a 23-18 squeaker decision

at Auburn one week ago.

The Wildcats (2-1) can recomp a large measure of lost prestige, if not their exact sixth place ranking in the national polls, by polishing off the tricky Seminoles (1-1) in this grudge match on Stoll Field tonight marking UK's second

venture outside the Southeastern Conference.

A year ago, fat and sassy Kentucky ran into an ambush in Seminole country. Young and lager Florida State was in no mood to respect UK's perfect, 3-0 record (a win over Detroit and back-to-back upsets of Ole Miss and Auburn that rocked the grid world). With much aid from the excellent combo of Steve Tensi to Fred Biletnikoff and other underrated hands, the Seminoles rolled to three touchdowns in the company quarter Kentscher and state and its ball. in the opening quarter. Kentucky never recovered its balance and the resulting setback proved the worst endured by the UKats in 20 years.

Coach Charlie Bradshaw's never-say-die warriors, on the strength of the way they battled back heroicly against vengeful Auburn, likely will rate the nod as a slight favorite over

the troubled Seminoles.


Just as likely, however, the experts are underselling ambitious Florida State and overemphasizing the UK revenge motive. Even without the services of the main standouts who engineered the '64 shellacking, the Seminoles are classed as dangerous to deal with. Still around to give the UK offense trouble are such key operatives as middle guard Jack Shinholser, linebacker Bill McDowell and tackle Frank Pennie. Offensive threats are halfback Phil Spooner and quarterback Ed Pritchett, both seniors. For its part, Kentucky may be forced to stifle a measure of its burning desire to go all out for revenge. On tap following the Seminoles is powerful Louisiana State, another Tiger band and one thirsting for victories that will get them back into SEC contention.

While the game tonight will not count in the league standings, Kentucky can be counted on to demonstrate its right to be regarded as a continuing contender. The Wild-cats were storming back from the brink of a Florida State-type humiliation last week against determined Auburn. Down 17-0 in the third period, UK rode the strong right arm of Rick Norton to three long touchdowns. Only missed gambles (necessitated by an Auburn field goal in the second quarter) for two-point conversions cost them comefrom-behind victory.

UK will be gunning for its third win in a challenging season. Prior to the Auburn setback, the 'Cats trimmed Missouri, 7-0, and performed flawlessly to down Ole Miss, 16-7. Florida State dropped a narrow, 7-3 decision to TCU in its opener and last week nudged Baylor, 9-7 to get into the win column.

The Kentucky-Florida State series, begun in 1960 at Tallahassee with a 23-0 Wildcat win, stands 2-1-1 in favor of the Blue Grass eleven. The upset last year gave FSU its only points in the four meetings. The tie came as the result of a scoreless standoff in Lexington in 1962.

SEIPLE SEES DAYLIGHT—Kentucky's "man of the hour," tailback Larry Seiple (32), finds running room through the Ole Miss defense during a critical stage of the thrill-packed battle on Stoll Field two weeks ago. This run was typical of the red-haired junior's ambling that netted 159 yards for the Wildcat cause in a 16-7 victory featured by his production of two touchdowns. On this jaunt, Seiple eludes would-be Mississippi tacklers Rocky Fleming (81) and Tommy Luke (35).
