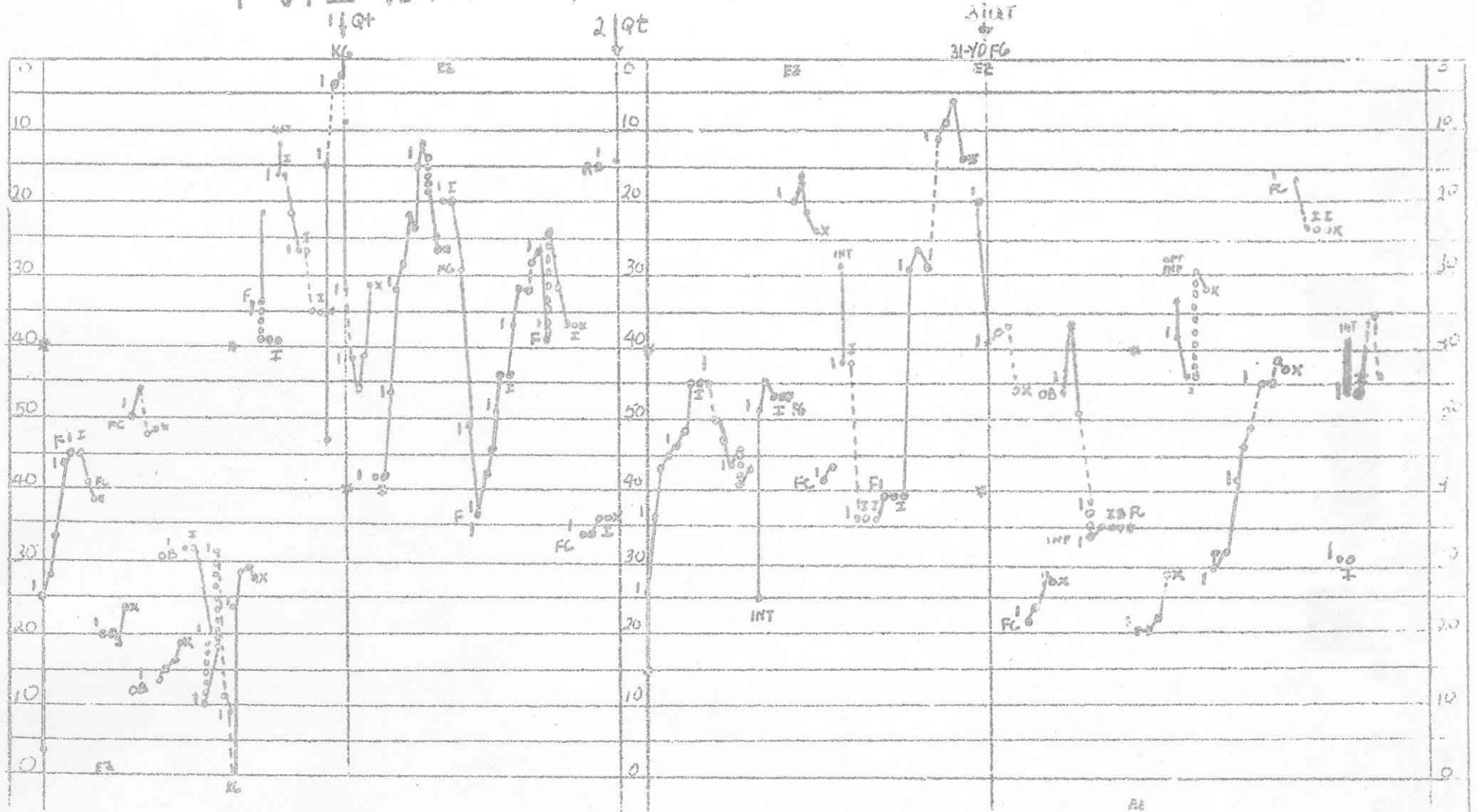

Quotes from Coach Peterson:

"As all ways VPI played well against us. But still that punt return was the difference. Our defense was exceptional. However, we made too many offensive mistakes.

"But we didn't get beat and that's unusual up here. That wind certainly was a factor. In fact I've never seen Virginia Tech punt that badly.

"Carrell got off a bad kick but he punted very well after that one.

This was our best defensive effort of the half season. Our secondary was hitting some licks and I know there was some knocking up there in the front line.

"Edwards is a tough kid to bring down. He ran well. So did Smoot.

"Magalski had another outstanding game.

"We dropped too many passes. We just weren't catching very well.

"I would have let Guthrie try a 60-yard field goal late with that wind. That was sure a beauty he kicked."

quotes from Coach Claiborne:

"It's a shame to play that strong and wind up with just a tie. The little mistakes have kept us from being a great team all season, and they just keep popping up on us."

"Our defensive front four played a tremendous game. This has to have been their best year...they had a great pass rush and they put real pressure on Cappleman. I just can't say enough about Bocko, Creekmore, Pigninelli, Dawyot and Bria. And Pigninelli played a great game after having been in the infirmary three days last week.

"We fought our hearts out. The secondary did a good job of breaking the ball loose on several occasions. The defense played well enough for a win. But we failed twice on field goals and didn't get a TD when we had a first down on their 11 yard line and had to settle for a field goal.

"I felt like we were in control of the game. We wanted to receive in the second half and try to win with the winds at our backs in the fourth period. But Florida State wanted the same thing.

"We didn't have a good kicking game. And I said all week that the kicking game was going to be very important in this game. We covered well, returned well, but we did not punt well and we missed on two field goals.

"And I say that our kicking game was not good even though it did give us one good break..

"Yes sir, we played well. We played a really good game...and I wish we could have won it for our seniors."
