TODAY'S GAME

North Carolina State will be seeking revenge in today's regionally televised game.

Last year in Raleigh, Florida State made its first big move toward its third straight bowl bid by whipping the Wolfpack 48-7 in a game in which North Carolina State had been slightly favored.

This is the first of two straight television games involving N.C. State. The American Broadcasting Co. will carry today's game through most of the Southeast while next week's Wolfpack-Penn State contest will be viewed nationally as the second game of a college football doubleheader.

Coach Earle Edwards' team used a multiple offense which is basically a power rushing attack. Tailback Charlie Bowers is the Wolfpack's leading ground gainer with 632 yards in 156 attempts for a 4.1 average.

In the Edwards system, fullback Leon Rodgers is primarily a blocker. However, he has taken time off from that chore to carry the ball 32 times for a 5.3 average. He gained 76 yards in 11 carries last Saturday as Houston downed N.C. State 34-13.

Wingback Leon Mason has the club's best average (6.3) and most of his carries have come on reverses.

Bowers gained 113 yards in 17 tries against Houston and had a 64-yard touchdown run. That was the fourth time this season the 200-pound senior has been over the 100-yard mark.

N.C. State's defense is braced by giant tackle Ron Carpenter and middle guard George Smith. Carpenter, an All-America, is 6-5 and weighs 255 while Smith is a sophomore who beat out a veteran performer.

But for a pair of late, two-point conversions, the Wolfpack would come into today's game with 5-3 mark. Wake Forest scored late and pulled off the two-pointer for a 22-21 victory while Duke did the same thing for a 25-25 standoff.

Florida State, winless in its last two games, owns a 5-2-1 record following a 10-10 tie with Virginia Tech and last week's heart-breaking 28-26 loss to Memphis State.

In the Tiger contest, quarterback Bill Cappleman shattered his own passing mark with 508 yards gained through the air on 31 completions in 50 attempts.

N.C. State and the Seminoles have faced two mutual opponents. Florida State edged Miami 18-16 while the Wolfpack dropped a 23-13 decision to the Hurricanes. South Carolina defeated N.C. State 21-16 while the Seminoles whipped the Gamecocks 34-9.

The Seminoles lead N.C. State 7-4 in the series.
