

TODAY'S GAME

North Carolina State will be seeking revenge in today's regionally televised game.

Last year in Raleigh, Florida State made its first big move toward its third straight bowl bid by whipping the Wolfpack 48-7 in a game in which North Carolina State had been slightly favored.

This is the first of two straight television games involving N.C. State. The American Broadcasting Co. will carry today's game through most of the Southeast while next week's Wolfpack-Penn State contest will be viewed nationally as the second game of a college football doubleheader.

Coach Earle Edwards' team used a multiple offense which is basically a power rushing attack. Tailback Charlie Bowers is the Wolfpack's leading ground gainer with 632 yards in 156 attempts for a 4.1 average.

In the Edwards system, fullback Leon Rodgers is primarily a blocker. However, he has taken time off from that chore to carry the ball 32 times for a 5.3 average. He gained 76 yards in 11 carries last Saturday as Houston downed N.C. State 34-13.

Wingback Leon Mason has the club's best average (6.3) and most of his carries have come on reverses.

Bowers gained 113 yards in 17 tries against Houston and had a 64-yard touchdown run. That was the fourth time this season the 200-pound senior has been over the 100-yard mark.

N.C. State's defense is braced by giant tackle Ron Carpenter and middle guard George Smith. Carpenter, an All-America, is 6-5 and weighs 255 while Smith is a sophomore who beat out a veteran performer.

But for a pair of late, two-point conversions, the Wolfpack would come into today's game with 5-3 mark. Wake Forest scored late and pulled off the two-pointer for a 22-21 victory while Duke did the same thing for a 25-25 standoff.

Florida State, winless in its last two games, owns a 5-2-1 record following a 10-10 tie with Virginia Tech and last week's heart-breaking 28-26 loss to Memphis State.

In the Tiger contest, quarterback Bill Cappleman shattered his own passing mark with 508 yards gained through the air on 31 completions in 50 attempts.

N.C. State and the Seminoles have faced two mutual opponents. Florida State edged Miami 18-16 while the Wolfpack dropped a 23-13 decision to the Hurricanes. South Carolina defeated N.C. State 21-16 while the Seminoles whipped the Gamecocks 34-9.

The Seminoles lead N.C. State 7-4 in the series.

COACHES QUOTES:

EARLE EDWARDS, NORTH CAROLINA STATE:

"Their spurt at the end of the half and us not doing anything at the start of the third quarter took us out of the game. We were in position to do some good in the second half, but just didn't capitalize on it. Then that punt return increased the margin to a safe one for them. ~~Mark~~ Moody was also out at that point.

"I thought our offensive line, particularly Don Jordan, Dan Sarik and Robby ~~Evans~~ Evans did a good job. We were able to run on them, but we just couldn't overcome our too many mistakes. We have run fairly well most of the year, but have gotten into trouble with our passing game the past two games.

"I thought we played fairly well on defense, but they are a good passing team.

"We just made a couple of their scores too easy. We got an interception score (Yount), but it didn't take them long to get it back. The events at the end of the half hurt us badly. It was an unusual chain of events.

"I guess it just wasn't our day the way the ball bounced. Both teams made some bad mistakes and had some good plays, but unfortunately for us, we made the most mistakes and they evidently had most of the good plays. Or at least enough to win it."

MOODY APPARENTLY HAS A DISLOCATED RIGHT ELBOW. IT OCCURRED ON THE TACKLE AFTER THE INTERCEPTION OF THE SCREEN PASS. "I caught my arm between his legs and it was like a scissors cutting motion that caused the injury," said Moody on the sidelines.

QUOTES FROM BILL PETERSON:

"This was a tough game to get up for. But our seniors rose to the occasion.

"I thought we played pretty well. Offensively, we had hoped to get a couple on the scoreboard quick and make them get out of that ball control game.

"They went to double coverage in the second half. We got two backs hurt and this messed up our timing a little. Arthur Munroe got a hip pointer in the first quarterback and James Jarrett injured a shoulder just before halftime.

"Our defense scored just about as many points as the offense. They kept us out of trouble. Vohun's interception has to be the big play of the game.

"We fumbled a lot and I just don't know the reason. Maybe it's one of those years.

"North Carolina State has a good defensive football team. They were fired up before they had a score to settle from last season.

"Capplemann had a great game despite those interceptions. Those first two drives were things of beauty.

"We were trying to go deep on first down but we couldn't quite connect."
