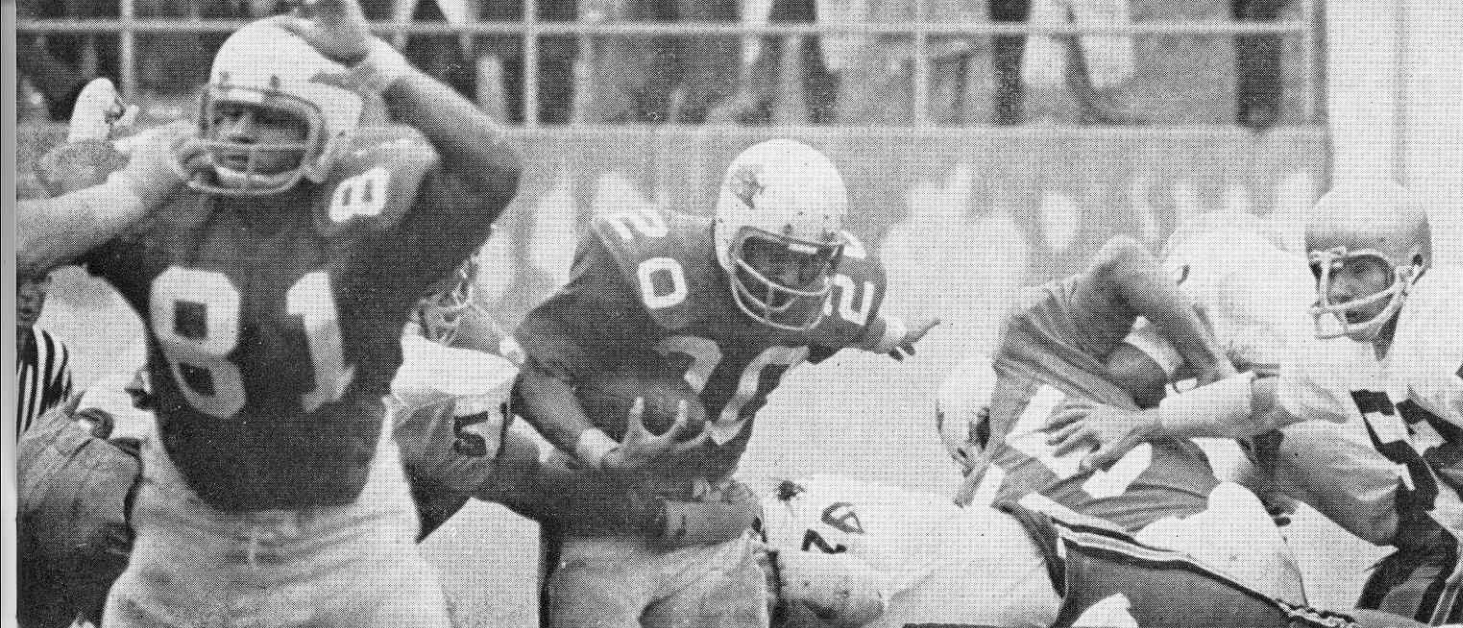

After years of watching Florida State's aerial-minded Seminoles against a grudging Virginia Tech defense, a fan might have trouble today identifying which team is which . . . although FSU still has the personnel for a strong passing game . . . with quarterback Gary Huff . . . and receivers like Rhett Dawson, Mike Glass, Barry Smith and Kent Gaydos . . . The Seminoles still throw the ball quite effectively . . . but new head coach Larry Jones also believes in a strong running game . . . and sound defense.

The Seminoles so far have run up a 3-0 record by polishing off Southern Mississippi (a future Tech opponent), Miami of Florida and the Kansas Jayhawks.

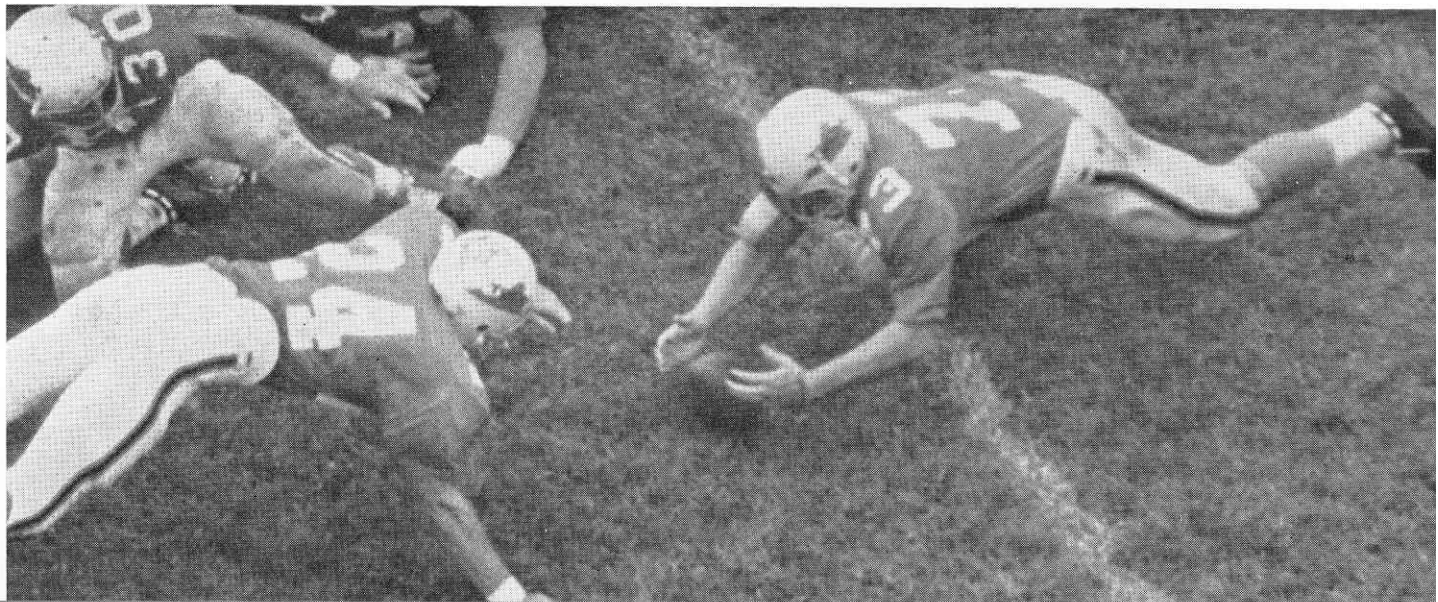
Tech, leaning heavily on a passing attack that is improving visibly by the day, is still a question mark simply because the Techmen haven't quite been able to pull off a victory in their first two

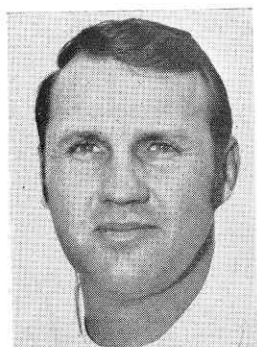
