Grant Field fans will get a chance to watch one of the nation's finest passing teams this afternoon as Georgia Tech strives to stretch its recent success against Florida State.

The Seminoles, who rested last Saturday, have compiled a 6-2 record mainly on the strength of an aerial attack built around junior quarterback Gary Huff (19) and split end Rhett Dawson (82). FSU won its first five games before being upset by Florida, then clobbered South Carolina, 49-18, before losing to Houston in its most recent outings.

The Yellow Jackets, on the other hand, have won three consecutive contests by combining a revitalized offense with their always stinging defense to go 5-4 on the season. Last week Tech rolled over Navy, 34-21, without the services of injured first string backs Rob Healy and Greg Horne. The issue never really was in doubt as the Engineers maneuvered to a 27-0 lead before nearly everyone got in the game.

Quarterback Eddie McAshan gained 165 total yards (114 passing on nine of 16 completions, 51 rushing on several nifty runs) to become only the second Jacket in history to crack the 1,000-yard mark in two straight seasons. He now has 1,075 yards to join all-America Billy Lothridge, who accomplished the feat in 1962-63, in that select club. Sterling defensive back Jeff Ford added some more lines bearing his name to the Tech record book by intercepting a pass and returning it 28 yards for a touchdown and also returning five punts for 63 yards. The interception gave Ford a career mark of 14, while the punt returns and yards established new season standards of 30 and 336, respectively.

Against the Middies Cunningham snared a nine-yard touchdown pass from McAshan, Cam Bonifay kicked field goals of 27 and 22 yards, Ford scored on his steal on the second half's first play and sophomore Tom Lang dived across the goal line from the one and then caught a two-point toss from Eddie before Navy scored. Alan Hennessey's six-yard run and Bobby Thigpen's conversion finished Tech's scoring.

Huff and Dawson are the dramatic reasons Florida State, under new coach Larry Jones, ranks so highly in national passing statistics. Huff, who has completed 143 of 240 passes (59.6%) for 2,019 yards and 16 touchdowns, is near the top in all aerial categories. Valdosta's Dawson has 48 receptions for 615 yards. But there are more Seminoles. Running backs Art Munroe (27), Paul Magalski (31) and James Jarrett (48) all are averaging better than four yards a carry. Defensive ringleaders include cornerbacks James Thomas (26) of Macon and Eddie McMillan (40), linebackers Larry Strickland (59) and Dan Whitehurst (50) of Adel, and ends Bill Shaw (85) of Marietta and Charlie Hunt (80).

The Jackets, who lead the FSU series, 7-0-1, conclude the regular season against Georgia here Thanksgiving night.
