

TONIGHT'S GAME

This will be the first meeting between independents Pittsburgh and Florida State and it closes out the regular schedule for both clubs although the Seminoles have a Dec. 27 Fiesta Bowl date against Arizona State in Phoenix.

The Panthers have faced a murderous schedule with the last two opponents being Notre Dame and Cotton Bowl-bound Penn State. Pitt was over-matched on both occasions, bowing to the Irish 56-7 and the Nittany Lions 55-18.

Defense has been the Panthers' problem most of the season since they have given up an average of 35.7 points per contest. Lack of experience has hurt since Pitt starts four sophomores on its defensive unit.

However, in senior linebacker Ralph Cindrich the Panthers have an All-America possibility.

Quarterback Dave Havern and split end Steve Moyer have turned into the greatest passer-receiver combination in Panther history. Moyer owns six Pitt career offensive records and Moyer, a 6-1, 190 pounder, broke the career reception record two weeks ago against Notre Dame.

With a total of four sophomores starting on defense and four more on offense, the Panthers have suffered growing pains, especially against such foes as Oklahoma, Notre Dame and Penn State.

Defensively, the Panthers present a sizable front five which is braced by left tackle Howard Broadhead, a 6-4, 265-pound senior.

Joel Klimek, senior tight end, is compared favorably with former Pitt All-America, Mike Ditka. Fullback Lou Julian is the leading rusher, averaging just under four yards per carry while Klimek and Moyer are Havern's favorite passing targets.
