# COACHE\*S COMMENTS ON FLORIDA STATE-AUBURN GAME Oct. 28, 1972 Cliff Hare Stadium

AUBURN HEAD COACH RALPH JORDAN: I was glad to see us come out and puts some points on the scoreboard early for a change...Thos first half interceptions really helped us...And except for for an unfortunate motion penalty we would have had another touchdown in the first half...But then FSU never gave up and they came back and brought the game to us in the second half...We didn't look like the same team in the second chalf and that is mostly due to FSU's tough play...Gary Huff looked like a different quarterback in the second half and he was just magnificent...We didn't execute our offense very well in the second half except for one touchdown pass...We did make a couple of fine goal line stands that certainly made a difference in the final score...

AUBURN INJURIES...James Owens strained knee doubtful for Florida...Limebacker Bill Newton sprained knee and doubtful for Florida...Johnny Simmons re-injured ankle and must wait and see on him...

F S U HEAD COAGH LARRY JONES: "It was a tough football game. Auburn has an outstanding club. They are the best physicall team overall that we have played this year. Nothing good happened to us early. Then when you're down 21-0 it's almost impossible to come back. However we had a lot of opportunities in the second half. I was extremely proud of the way our kids fought back. They didn't quit. Auburn did a fine job on defense. They secondary is very talented and they put a lot of pressure on up front. We had trouble doing anything in the first half and it was mainly because of the Auburn defense. I think the play that hurt us most was that deflected pass which cost us a down and 15 yards. We had good field position until then. The official called it right. We said that halftime that we were going to go back to the game plan and execute. We did fairly well over the final 30 minutes. Again I\*d like to say that Auburn is a fine football team.\*

FSU Injury situation: Hodges Mitchell has a dislocated shoulder and will be out two weeks. Defensive back Ron Ratliff pulled a hamstring muscle. Barry Smith played almost the entire game with a seperated shoulder which he received on his first reception.
