# TODAY'S GAME

Welcome parents, to the Florida State-Houston contest, an old and honorable rivalry which dates back to 1960.

This is the first time the Cougars have visited Doak Campbell Stadium since 1966 when they claimed a 21-13 victory.

In fact, the newest member of the Southwest Conference holds an 8-1-2 margin over Florida State. The Seminoles' lone win came at Jacksonville in 1968 when they pulled a major upset with a 40-20 triumph.

This is the youngest Cougar team Coach Bill Yeoman has ever started. There will be 12 sophomores on the two units going against the Seminoles and in the six previous seasons Coach Yeoman had only started 16.

Word is that Houston is talented but inexperienced. The Cougars have had their bright moments—against San Diego State they made very few mistakes and wound up a 49-14 winner.

Even in last week's 27-13 loss to Mississippi State, the Cougars had three chances within the 10 and didn't get a point. Still, the Bulldogs had to count two late fourth period touchdowns to win.

Fullback Puddin Jones is the Cougars' top ball carrier, averaging almost 100 yards per game. Quarterback D.C. Nobles is a talented rusher and passer.

One of the defensive stickouts is end Mack Mitchell, who played on the Houston basketball team last season and performed against the Seminoles in Tully Gym.

Adding a Florida flavor to the Houston lineup is running back Reggie Cherry, 185-pound sophomore from Lake Helen.

The Cougars come into this one at 2-4-1 with the main object being to still have a winning season. The last time they lost four games in one season was 1965.

Florida State, on the other hand, must regroup following its 27-14 loss to tough Auburn last Saturday. And the Seminoles must do it without some top performers who are injured. Running back Hodges Mitchell, who broke the school season rushing record against the Tigers, will sit it out due to a dislocated shoulder.

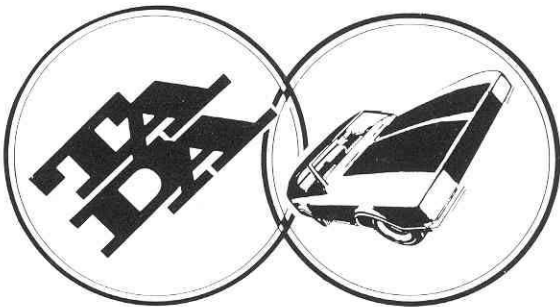

QUOTES FROM COACH LARRE JONES:

"Houston has a fine football team. They are so quick. All season they've been moving the ball well but making mistakes. Today they didn't make but one mistake.

"We had four turnovers in the first half and that's too many. That put us in such bad field position.

"When we didn't make that first down in the third quarter it really hurt us. You just have to make those kind.

FSU INJURY SITUATION-----Barry Smith suffered a moderate concussion and is okay. However, he will be put in the hospital overnight for observation.

Bobby Anderson, Mack Brown and Phil Arnold suffered knee injuries. Anderson's is the most severe and he will probably undergo surgery.
