It was certainly no exhibition ofm flawless football between all the mistakes and the penalties, but it was one of the finest efforts I've ever seen . We got shelled last week and came back with tremendous effort.

On that last touchdowntheyn made we had a safety blitz on with a freshman playing safety. He tipped the play and showed it and human didn't adjust. Then on that play that looked like an onsides kick...the kid just missed the ball. They wouldn't be going for an onsides kick with seven minutes left. That turned it into a reall heart stopper.

Florida State Coach Larry Jones:

We had opporatunities and once again we made too many mistakes. I am proud that our team didn't quit and that we had the opportunity to try and come back. I have no excuses for the turnovers.

We did slip and fall on a lot of pass patterns and this was the first time we have played on artificial turf this year. We just missed on somelong pass connections.

On defense we had one bad breakdown on that long run (Lacy). We (cozches) were confused on that penalty the play before the long run. We thought it was a five yarder, but it was 15. We should have taken thepenalty. On the play when we missed down thereon the four yard line, Mitchell slipped or I think he could have made it.

In some ways we made progress and others we didn't. We've got a lot of people injured on defense and this is hurtingd

Baylor is very tough. They have some good, strong running backs. We opened up a little more on offense in this game.
