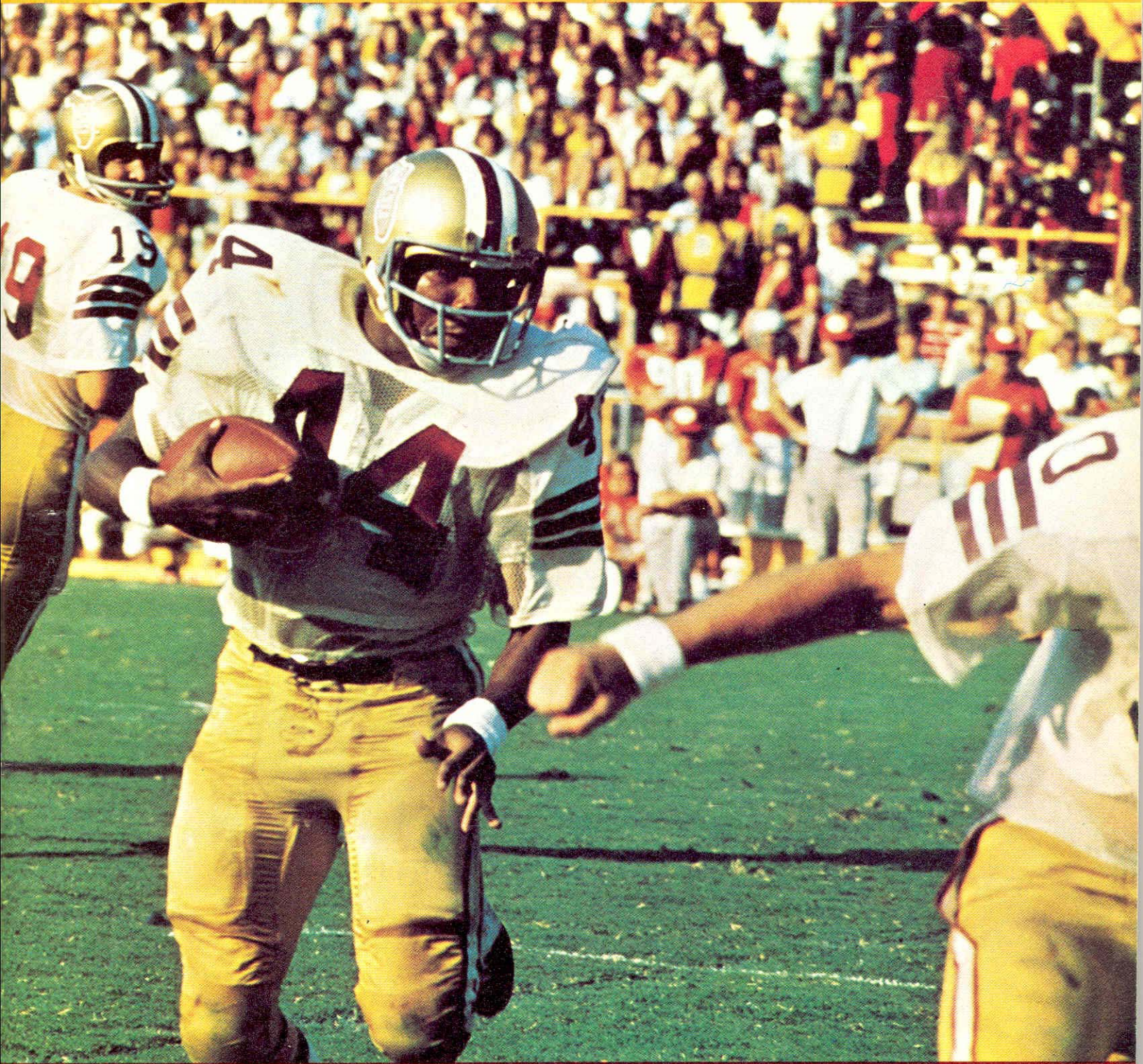

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TODAY'S GAME

Mississippi State, Florida State's opponent today, appears to be the most improved club in the Southeastern Conference.

The Bulldogs come into this contest with a 2-1-1 record including a pair of SEC victories which include a 33-13 decision over Florida. The other conference win was at the expense of Vanderbilt, 52-21, while Northeastern Louisiana pulled a 21-21 surprise in the Bulldog opener.

Last Saturday night, Kentucky stunned Mississippi State 42-14 as the Wildcats rolled over what had been a stout Bulldog defense.

In quarterback Rocky Felker, the 'Dogs own the SEC total offense leader. The six-foot junior has passed for 615 yards and rushed for 200 more. So in four games he has accounted for an average of about 204 yards per contest while passing for seven scores and rushing for three more.

It was Felker who entered the game late last season and almost pulled it out for the Bulldogs as Florida State hung on for a 25-21 victory.

The top Mississippi State rusher is 210-pound fullback Wayne Jones who has gained 414 yards in 70 carries for a 5.9 average. All-Conference receiver Bill Buckley has 20 receptions for 280 yards and four TDs.

In defensive end Jimmy Webb, a 6-5, 245-pound junior, the Bulldogs think they have at least an all-conference performer.

This will be the seventh meeting between Florida State and the Bulldogs with Mississippi looking for its first triumph.

QUOTES FROM MISSISSIPPI STATE COACH BOB TYLER:

"We played well with the exception of penalties especially fourth down penalties. They are the worst kind. I think our rushers were going around the blockers taking the wrong angle.

I think the penalties kept us backed up and kept us from getting the ball for the offense, especially in the second quarter.

~~Tex~~ Today was our day. Florida State kept coming after us. The fumbles early in the game hurt them. I think FSU's young players did a good job, just the fumbles hurt bad.

I thought our secondary did a fine job. I am proud of our whole football team.

(Felker received an injury to his hand and will not know until tomorrow how bad it is hurt.)

FROM COACH LARRY JONES:

"It was the worst start I've ever seen. There is no way you can play that way with those mistakes. We just weren't ready to play.

"Mississippi State is a good football team. Some of those wins they have proved that.

"Felker is the best quarterback we've played against. He is really a fine athlete. And they have a lot of other fine ones.

"We wanted to give Mark Orlando a chance all along but the way things were going we didn't. We saw Orlando do some good things and bad things. We won't make up our minds on who is No. 1 until we see the film and have some staff meetings.

"I liked the way Larry Jones and Mike Schumann caught the ball. Schumann has some quickness. He's caught some passes before but hasn't had a chance to make his moves.

"We're not going to use young people just to be getting experience. We are still trying to win that first game--not look to next year."
