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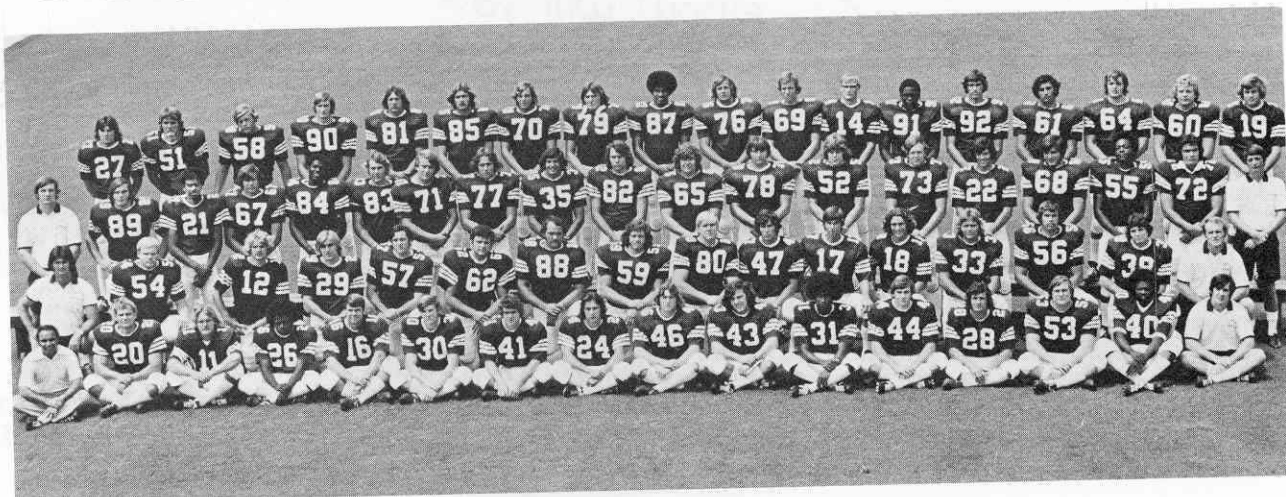
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FRESHMAN FOOTBALL



Pictured above are the 1973 freshman football players at Florida State University. With the freshmen now eligible for varsity competition, many of these young men are familiar to Seminole fans. The freshman eligibility rule has also caused a change in "freshman games" as many are now played as "junior varsity" contests with members of the "Scout Squad," upper classmen who do not dress for varsity games, joining the frosh. Florida State's freshmen reported the same day as the varsity and have been hard at work ever since. They have three games under their belts and are looking forward to two more—against Miami, in the Orange Bowl, Oct. 27, and against Florida here in Campbell Stadium on Nov. 10. Head Coach of the Freshmen is Ed Feely, who explains the emphasis of the program; "We have three things we try to do with the freshmen. We help the varsity prepare for its upcoming games, however and whenever, needed. We try to familiarize the freshmen with the Florida State system and fundamentals. And we try to instill a winning attitude. This year's team understands this and is dedicated to doing the best it can in all three areas."

TODAY'S GAME

Memphis State, Florida State's homecoming opponent today, is probably one of the country's fastest college football teams.

The Tigers, 4-2 for the season, will start four offensive players who run the 100-yard dash in 9.7 seconds or less.

At wide receivers, Memphis State has Joe Thompson (9.7) and freshman Bobby Ward (9.6). At tailback is Dornell Harris (9.7) and Clifton Taylor (9.6) is the fullback.

Ward, a freshman from Miami, gave the Tigers the cushion they needed last Saturday night against Tulsa when he caught a 62-yard scoring bomb with three seconds remaining in the first half. He also is among the nation's top 10 punt returners with a 19.6 average.

On the throwing end of that 62-yard bomb was quarterback Joe Bruner, a Fort Walton Beach native who transferred from Auburn.

Tailback Harris is the third-leading rusher in Memphis State history while fullback Taylor has scored six touchdowns in as many games. Thompson, the other wide receiver, was the country's 12th-leading receiver going into the Tulsa contest.

Safety Ray Wallace has won Memphis State's defensive player of the week three times while linebacker Steve McCarty leads the team in tackles.

The Tigers started off as a conservative offensive team but took to the air more when Bruner became the starting quarterback. In their last three games, the Tigers have averaged more than 20 passes per contest.
