


# San Diego State vs. Florida State

## SCOUTING REPORT

## OPPONENT: Florida State University DATE: October 27, 1973

OFFENSE — The Florida State offense is centered around the passing arms of quarterbacks Billy Sexton and Mark Orlando and the running of Hodges Mitchell.

Sexton started the season as the No. 1 quarterback and has hit 39 of 92 passes for 538 yards, but gave way last week to the sophomore Orlando against Memphis State. Orlando has hit 36 of 68 for 314 yards.


Mitchell, picked up 944 yards last season on the ground on a Gary Huff dominated passing team. He has rushed for 375 yards this season on 96 carries. Bobby McKinnon is the No. 2 rusher with 172 yards on 43 carries and broke one run for 74 yards and a score against Memphis State.

The top receivers are Mike Allen, 13 catches for 176 yards, Mike Shumann, 11 catches for 162 yards, and Joe Goldsmith seven catches for 131 yards.

**DEFENSE** — Young and inexperience are the terms that best describe the Florida State defense.

Seniors Jim Malkiewicz and Dave Miles could be the two best players. Malkiewicz (6-2, 225) is a defensive tackle while Miles (5-10, 201) is a linebacker. Miles saw more playing time than any other Seminole linebacker in 1972.

John Murphy (5–8, 205) and Greg Pounds (6–1, 211) are two steady players at linebacker with Buzzy Lewis a solid player in the secondary.

### TONIGHT'S GRID NOTES

San Diego State and Florida State rank one, two in Passing Offense in the nation over the past five years in statistics release by the NCAA. The Aztecs are No. 1 with an average per game of 280.5 while Florida State is second at 263.3. The Aztecs are a little off that figure this season, averaging 209.3 yards passing while Florida State has slipped this season to 142.0. The complete rundown on the top 20 passing teams in the nation over the past five years can be found on page 23 of the program.


At halftime tonight the Aztecs have scheduled a most unusual event. The Aztecs will honor their intermational track stars Steve Williams, and James Redd. They will run an exhibition race, along with another Aztec sprinter Harold Williams, and each will represent a local charity. The event is sponsored by Safeway Stores of San Diego County. The event will be followed by High School Band night, featuring nine high school bands and the Marching Aztecs.

The pro report from last week on former Aztec players was very good. Fred Dryer of the Los Angeles Rams set an NFL record by getting two safties in the same game against the Green Bay Packers. Isaac Curtis caught eight passes for 105 yards for the Cincinnati Bengals. The one bad note is that Willie Buchanon of the Packers broke his leg against the Rams and will be lost for the season. Buchanon broke the leg in a freak injury while guarding Jack Snow of the Rams.

Most everyone knows about the former Aztecs in the pro ranks, but Florida State has had its share of great players. Some of the former Seminole greats include: Fred Biletnikoff, Rhett Dawson, Gary Huff, Eddie McMillen, Gary Parris, Ron Sellers, Barry Smith, Walt Sumner, Bill Cappleman and Steve Tensi.

Tonight's game marks the first time Florida State has played in California. The Seminoles very rarely travel west of the Mississippi River.

Florida State coach Larry Jones is the inventor of the famous Tennessee defense while he was at the University of Tennessee in 1970. Prior to coaching at Tennessee Jones was at LSU under Paul Dietzel who had a pretty good defensive group known as the "Chinese Bandits" a few years ago.



## LARRY JONES Wide-Open Football

In two full seasons as head football coach at Florida State, Larry Jones has directed the Seminoles to 15 victories against eight defeats.

The personable Arkansas native guided the Seminoles to an 8-3 and a Fiesta Bowl bid in his first year and last season Florida State had a 7-4 mark despite numerous injuries. Since coming to Florida State from South Carolina,

Since coming to Florida State from South Carolina, Jones has continued the Seminole tradition of wide-open football. "When I came here, I knew Florida State was a passing football team," said Jones. "I believe in the passing game and we will continue in that direction. That certainly doesn't mean I'm against a sound running attack. They compliment each other. To have a successful offense you have to be able to do both."

When the Seminoles won eight games in 1971, it was only the fifth time in Florida State's 26-year football history that a coach had been able to match that figure.

Jones, 39, is not totally offense oriented. "No team can win consistently without a sound defense," said the former LSU player. "Offense is the more glamorous side of football but I think defensive players take just as much pride in stopping the opposition."

A native of Little Rock, Ark., Jones was a three-spot performed at Little Rock High School. He attended LSU from 1951-54 where he was center-linebacker for the Tigers. He joined the LSU coaching staff under Paul Dietzel the day he graduated in 1954.








