Today's Game

If a pre-season prognosticator had predicted that Florida State and Virginia Tech would come into this game with a combined record of 1-16, he would have been laughed out of business.

But it's no laughing matter today. Perennially two of the nation's best independents, FSU and Tech are struggling to salvage whatever minute consolation might be left in a nightmarish season.

But College football, thriving on the unpredictability that always has made it great, might afford this young (1955) but hotly contested series its own showcase for the day.

The Seminoles, long one of the most prolific offensive producers in college football, have been having troubles putting points on the scoreboard — nine tds and four FG's in eight games for FSU is absolute starvation.

Tech, on the other hand, has been overindulgent with the enemy — giving up 47 tds and an average 38

points in nine games.

Both teams have been somewhat snakebit in the course of meeting tough schedules. In its first six losses FSU played reasonably well and four of the losses were by a total of 16 points.

Tech, too, experienced some early season setbacks in which the Gobblers seemed to be a day late and a dollar short.

The Seminole defense, which has been the most positive of FSU's game, will challenge the Gobbler offense, which until last Saturday appeared to be constantly improving.

Despite the records, today's game presents three of the finest runners in college football: FSU's Hodges Mitchell and Tech's Phil Rogers and James Barber.

The most certain thing about today's contest is that neither side likely would care if the points were scored by the waterboy. Each simply would like to win!

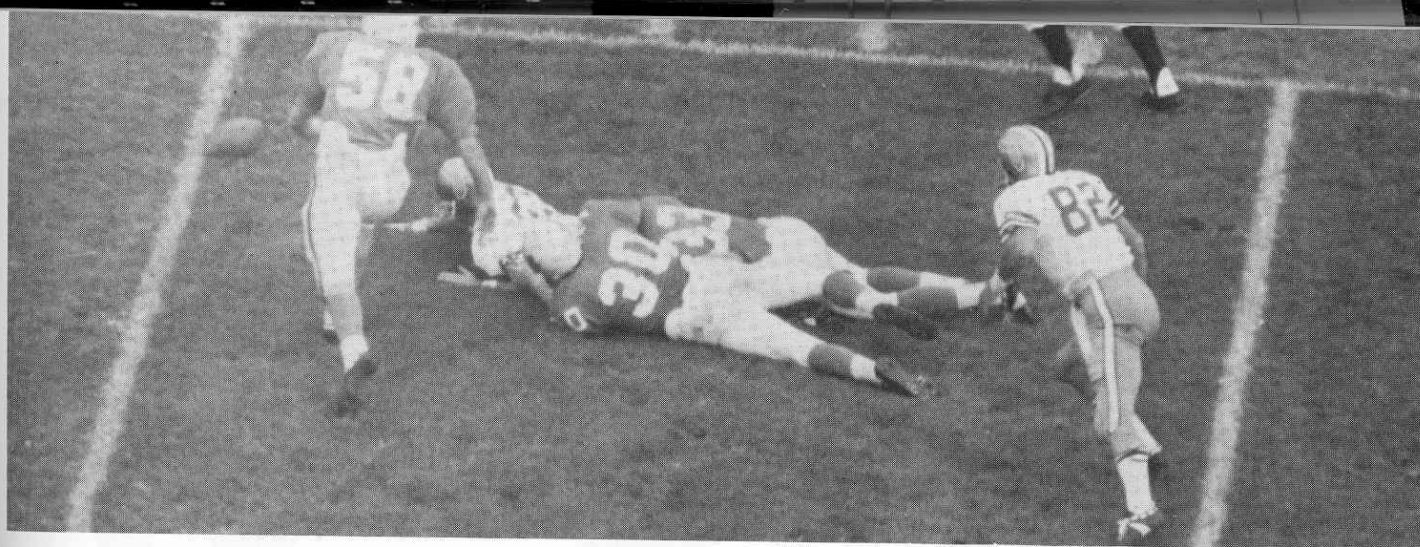

Hokies, Seminoles Provide Good Competition

It's been a long season for both teams on the field today. There's no denying that. But Virginia Tech and Florida State, perennially two of the South's top independents, will probably put on a good show for the fans today, if past form holds true.

Although it is not a series dating way back into the early part of the century or the latter part of the 1800's, Virginia Tech and Florida State have had something good going since 1955 that has turned out to be a fine rivalry.

Last season it was the Florida State game which helped turn Tech's season around despite the fact that the Seminoles won, 27-15. The Gobblers were coming off a disheartening loss to Virginia and the young club showed some progress against the tough Seminoles. The Hokies went on to score big victories over SMU

and Oklahoma State and tie Houston in the next three games.

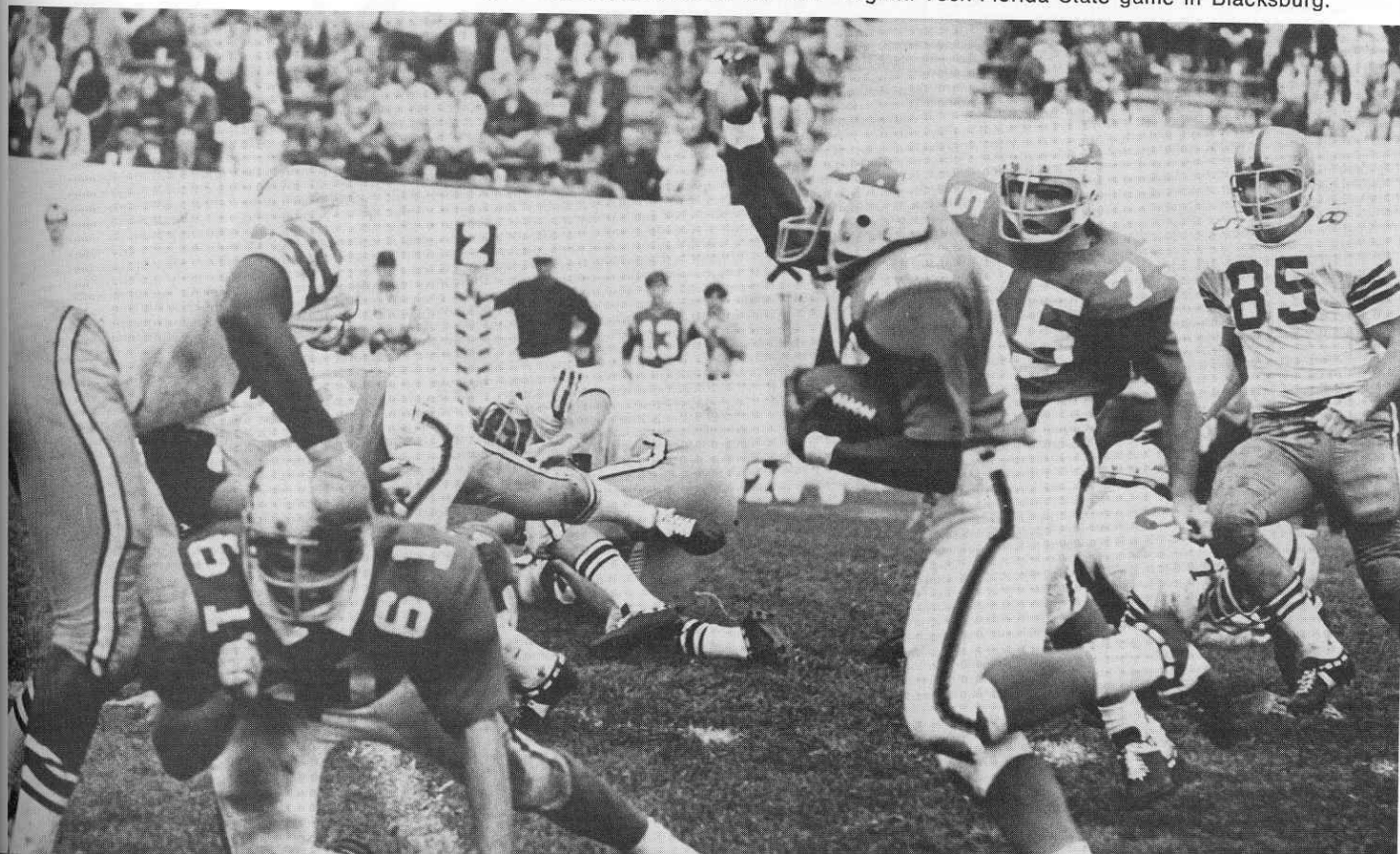
The victory last season pushed Florida State over the top in the series between the two teams with an 8-7-1 lead. The Seminoles have actually won the last three in a row, with Tech's last victory coming in 1968 at Tallahassee, Fla., 40-22.

For the most part, when the Hokies have won they have scored well. In six of their seven victories Tech has scored 20 or more points, but has never accomplished that feat in any of the losses or the tie.

There has been just one shutout in the series, Florida State's 28-0 win in 1958.

A victory today could help make things much easier to take during what will have to be a long winter for both teams.

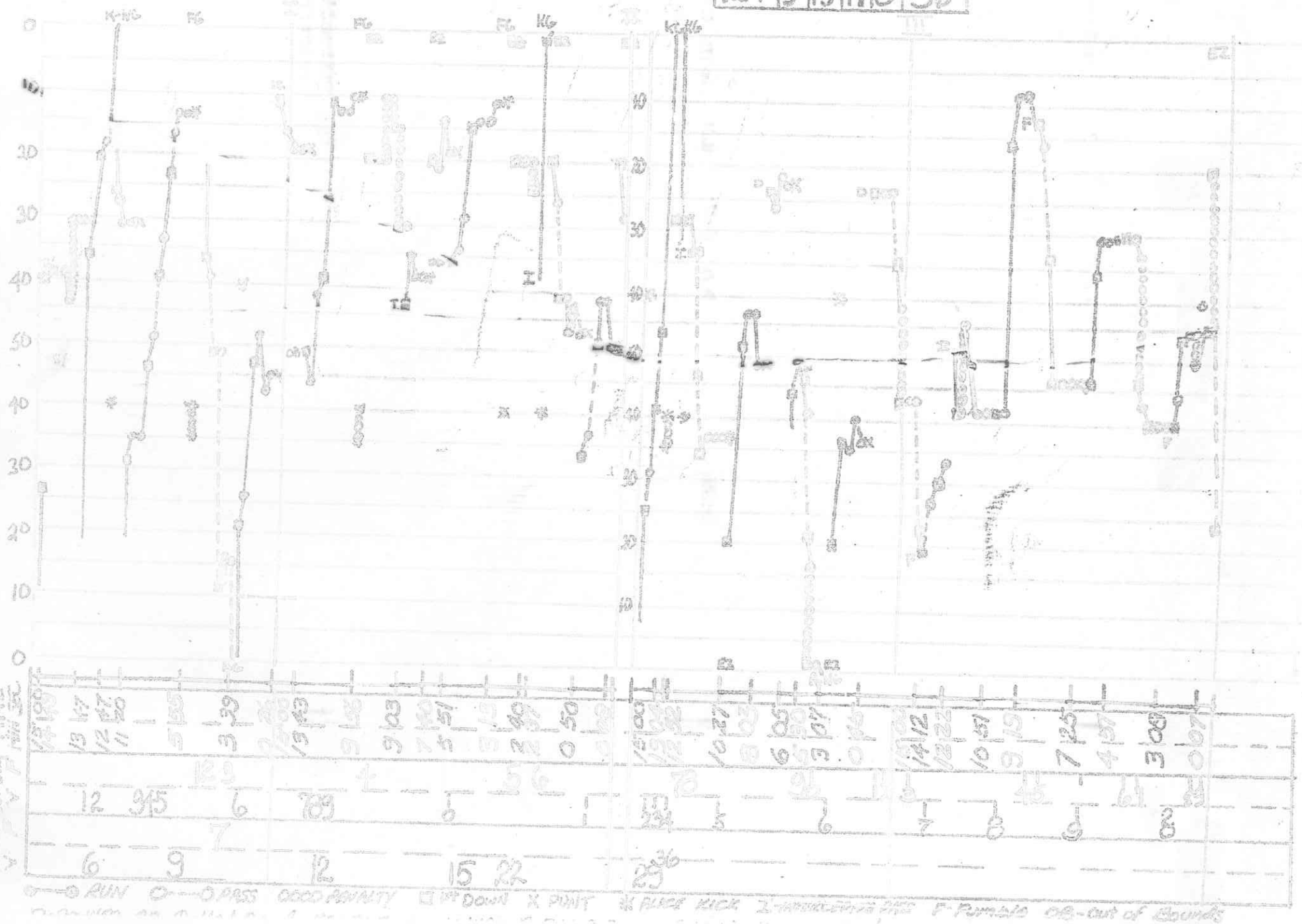
