Gator Talk



Back in 1909 the University of Florida football team swept through the last five games with four wins and a tie. They beat Rollins, 28-3, Olympics 11-0, and 28-0 and tied Stetson 5-5, before their final game.

A win in that one by the margin of 26-0 set a standard which is still standing today. The four wins and tie make up the finest five-game finish in Gator grid history.

The final win, by the way, in that historic march came over Tallahassee Athletic Club.

Today Coach Doug Dickey's 1973 Gators have a chance to better that mark and they, too, must face a team from Tallahassee. This one is a traditional foe in a young series which have already become one of the most competitive around.

Dickey's club has now won four straight. They have beaten Auburn, Georgia, Kentucky and Miami, in four tough, hard-fought football games which went down to the wire. The total victory margin was 14 points, seven of this amount coming in the Miami game.

There are several interesting points to consider prior to today's game. First, the Seminoles are very much in the same sort of position the Gators found themselves in just before the Auburn game.

F.S.U. has had injury problems, they have turned the ball over on offense and put too much pressure on their defense. They have had a week off to regroup and get back some injured players.

Those who think back to the days before the Auburn game remember this was virtually the spot the Gators were in. They took the week off, regrouped and came back to get a first-ever victory at Auburn and start their current four-game streak.

Also, in 1971 the Gator's beat F.S.U., 17-15. Florida went into the game with a perfect record in reverse, having won none and lost five. F.S.U. was unbeaten.

All of which should be sobering facts for Gator fans.
