Florida State Opens Home Schedule

Whoever made up the old saw that statistics don't lie obviously wasn't well versed in the two-game stats of both Kansas and Florida State.

If a more precise phrase could be used to apply to the Jayhawks and Seminoles, it would be simply this: The scoreboard doesn't lie.

Today's opponents in Kansas' home football opener have both displayed strong but not overwhelming defense so far this season. And both have moved the ball well, but have been unable to cross the goal line as much as they should.

Florida State, mired in one of the nation's longest major college losing streaks (14 in a row), has nothing but two losses to show despite strong showings against highly-regarded Pittsburgh and up and coming Colorado State.

It took a field goal for Pitt to squeeze out a 9-6 triumph over the Seminoles in a game that saw FSU gain more yardage than the Panthers.

Last week Florida State couldn't get anything going offensively until late in the game. A fourth quarter Ron Coppess to Joe Goldsmith TD pass was all they could muster against the Rams.

Both those games were in Tallahassee. Kansas, meanwhile, played its first two outings on the road and at night. The Jayhawks whipped Washington State, 14-7,

then bowed last Saturday at Tennessee, 17-3.

Kansas coach Don Fambrough is mystified about his team's inability to put the ball in the end zone. The Jayhawks are averaging a whopping 417 yards of total offense per game, but only 8.5 points per contest.

One of the reasons is KU's poor showing in third down situations. On first and second down plays, the Jayhawks are averaging about 14 yards a crack.

But third downs are something else. A total of 25 third down situations have found KU converting first downs only 20 per cent of the time.

New Florida State coach Darrell Mudra is, of course, looking for an upset. Already Mudra is well-known for turning grid programs

around and he has to figure this is as good a place as any to get the Seminoles righted.

A 44-year-old native of Omaha, Mudra went to Tallahassee from Western Illinois.

In his first coaching job in 1959, Mudra took an Adams (Colo.) State team that went 1-9 and turned it around to 8-1. In 1963 he moved to North Dakota which had been 0-10 before his arrival. In the next three years under Mudra, NDS went 3-5, 10-1, 11-0.

Next Mudra turned the program around at Arizona and finally at Western Illinois where in the last five years he compiled a 39-13 record.

Mudra is no stranger to upsets. His 1967 Arizona team, although compiling a season log of 3-6-1, knocked off Ohio State in Columbus.

Today's game brings to an end a four-year series between Kansas and Florida State.

The Seminoles won the first two, 30-7 at Tallahassee and 1971 and 44-22 here in 1972. Kansas dumped the Seminoles, 28-0, last year in Tallahassee.

A couple of members of the Kansas athletic department have ties at Florida State. KU athletic director Clyde Walker's son, Clyde Jr., is a sophomore quarterback at FSU although he wasn't expected to make the trip here today.

And assistant athletic director Doug Messer came here after serving in a similar capacity at Florida State.

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
