While tonight's game with Iowa State will be the first between the two schools, Florida State has played four other members of the Big 8 Conference. The overall record against Big 8 schools is 4-3. The Tribe is 2-2 against Kansas, 1-0 with Kansas State and Oklahoma and 0-1 against Oklahoma State.

Don Veller, former Head Coach (1948-52) will miss his first Seminole home game since he first came to Florida State at the start of the Seminoles' second season.

Now the Tribe's golf coach, he has taken the squad to Callaway Gardens for the Southern Intercollegiate Tournament this weekend.

Leon Bright's 30 carries in last week's game against Utah State was a new Florida State record for carries. The previous mark of 29 was set by Fred Pickard back in 1959 and tied by Larry Green in 1968.

Bright has the opportunity for another first this week as no Seminole runner has ever put three 100-yard plus games together consecutively. He had 102 yards against Texas Tech in the season opener and 138 last weekend.

STATISTICS CORRECTION - One of last week's interceptions by the Seminoles was mistakenly credited to Lee Nelson. Nelson had one interception with a return of 14 yards. The second one credited to him should have gone to Detroit Reynolds (with no return yards.) Bobby Jackson also had one interception.

Florida State has not had back-to-back wins since 1972, when the Seminoles defeated Mississippi State 25-21 and Colorado State 37-0 on Oct. 14 and 21. The Tribe has not won two straight home games since Nov. 20 and 27, 1971 when they beat Tulsa 45-10 and Pittsburgh, 31-13.

Mike Shumann moved ahead of Don Floyd in career statistics for passes caught and yards receiving with his three catches for 59 yards against Texas Tech. Shumann now ranks seventh in passes caught with 67, 11 short of Kent Gaydos' sixth place total. His 954 yards receiving total is just four yards shy of Gaydos' seventh place total.

Iowa State will be bringing nine players and four members of its coaching staff with Florida and/or South Georgia ties. Earle Bruce was head coach at Tampa in 1972 and he has three assistants from his Spartan staff with him in Ames, including Charlie Lyle, Randy Hart and Tom Backhus. Among the players making the trip are Luther Blue from Valdosta and Klarence Isler of Albany. Players from the Sunshine State are Randy Young (Miami), Glover Rogers (Opalocka), Wayne Stanley (Belle Glade), Ray Hardee (Mulberry), Otis Rogers (Tampa), Greg Pittman (San Antonio) and Jimmy Randolph (Jacksonville).
