QUOTES FROM GEORGIA TECH COACH PEPPER RODGERS:

I got a lot of instruction this week in the mail and I put some of it in. All of the instruction came from fans. No Coaches wrote in. ~~xx~~ They have been beaten before. People that write in have never been beaten before. It's like me, I haven't missed a tennis shot in a year, I haven't hit one.
