FLORIDA STATE (1-4) vs. FLORIDA (4-1)
Seminoles Gators

October 18, 1975
Florida Field, Gainesville, FL
Kickoff: 2 p.m.
Estimated Attendance: 62,000

OCCASION: Florida State vs. Florida

BROADCAST: The game will be heard throughout the state over the Seminole and Gator Radio Networks.

THE SERIES: Florida leads 14-2-1 and has won seven straight since the Seminoles last victory in 1967. The other FSU win came in 1964 and the tie was in 1961. Florida's biggest win in the series came two years ago at Florida Field by a 49-0 count.

LAST MEETING: October 19, 1974 in Tallahassee. The Gators grabbed a 10-0 first half lead. The Seminoles cut the margin to 10-7 in the third period, but Florida scored twice in the fourth quarter to put the game out of reach. A final Tribe TD made the final 24-14.

1975 RECORDS: Florida State (Texas Tech 20-31; Utah State 17-8; Iowa State 6-10; Georgia Tech 0-30; Virginia Tech 10-13). Florida (SMU 40-14; N.C. State 7-8; Mississippi State 27-10; LSU 34-6; Vanderbilt 35-0).

LAST WEEK: Florida State bowed to Virginia Tech 13-10 on a 61-yard field goal by Wayne Latimer in the fourth period. The Seminole defense came forward with its finest effort of the season. Meantime, Florida got an 80-yard touchdown run on the first offensive play from Jimmy DuBose and then three TDs from Larry Brinson as the Gators won their fourth game, downing Vanderbilt 35-0. Florida has allowed only one touchdown in their last two games and currently leads the nation in total offense with 442.2 yards per game.

CAPTAINS: Florida State captains Greg Johnson and Jeff Gardner will be joined by game co-captains to be named later this week. Florida captains to be announced later in the week.

FLORIDA STATE TRAVEL PLANS: The Seminoles will fly to Gainesville the morning of the game, going directly to Florida Field from the airport. The team will return to Tallahassee immediately following the game.

INJURIES: Florida State's Leon Bright, the team's leading rusher, is probably out for the game with a shoulder injury. Linebacker Brian Schmidt, who didn't make the Virginia Tech trip due to a shoulder injury, is expected to be back. Gator running back Earl Carr suffered a bruised back but should be ready. Defensive back Wayne Fields returned to the practice field but is doubtful for Saturday.

DARRELL MUDRA: "Florida is one of the best teams in the country. Our coaches say they are by far the strongest team we have played. They have the people to run the wishbone extremely well and they do. They are tougher defensively than they thought they would be and they're very quick."
