Quotes from Coach Darrell Mudra:

"Naturally, we're pleased because it looks like we might have turned the corner with our team. We played a lot of kids. Early in the game it looked like we were aggressive and knew what we were doing.

Edwards) and Bill (athletic director Bill McLellan), ~~manages~~ ~~is~~ the greatest people in the world for support, I'll tell them I think we need a new football coach at Clemson.
