Tonight's Game

Eagles - Seminoles in 13th Meeting...

There's no question that records will be set in the 13th meeting of the homestanding Golden Eagles and the Florida State University Seminoles.

Tailback Larry Key of FSU claimed his school's all-time career rushing record last year and Ben (Go-Go) Garry surpassed the ole USM career mark when he rambled for 126 yards against Troy State last week.

Key, a 5-10, 180-pound senior from Inverness, Fla., has 1,836 yards for three campaigns. The total includes his 724 yards on 144 efforts last year.

The talented Garry, also a senior and the Pride of Pascagoula, Miss., now has 2,587 yards. The swift youngster spun his way for 1,236 stripes last season to eclipse the one-year record at USM. So, each time one of the two rushing aces puts a yard in the books, a new standard will be set.

It could be that Go-Go will get more opportunities than Key, since it's anticipated the Seminoles will spend considerable time 'putting the ball up.' Always a pass-oriented team, FSU has another on its long list of talented throwers. He's sophomore quarterback Jimmy Jordan of Tallhassee, home of the school.

Much heralded when recruited by the Seminoles, Jordan responded with an impressive freshman campaign while playing in the shadow of the now-departed Jimmy Black. For the year, Jordan completed 23 of 50 passes for 434 yards and two touchdowns. These totals do not include those he amassed while also playing with the Seminole junior varsity.

A bevy of standout receivers awaits Jordan's arrival as the varsity starter. His prep teammate, Kurt Unglaub, is among the catchers. Kurt broke in as a freshman by making 33 grabs for 665 yards and four touchdowns.

Others include Mike Shumann, whose total of 102 catches ranks him fourth in FSU history. He returns to the squad this year after a one-year absence for disciplinary reasons. Then there are Jackie Flowers, who caught nine for 160 years and one score last year, and Mike Barnes, who grabbed eight for 194 and a TD.

Going into tonight's contest, the Eagles hold a 6-5-1 lead in the series that began in 1952.

Southern won four of six games played in the 1950's. In the 60's, Southern won two games, FSU one and the teams struggled to a scoreless tie in '63.

The Seminoles took a 24-9 win in '71 and then came from way back to trip the Eagles 30-27 last year.

In the '76 scramble at Tallahassee, the Eagles led 27-10 after three quarters. The Seminoles rallied for a pair of sustained drives and then got the winning points on a 95-yard screen pass with 3:59 left in the contest.
