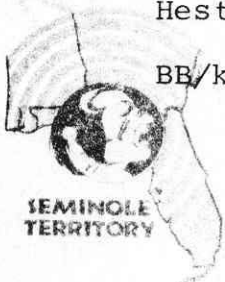

"When Jimmy threw that TD pass to Homes Johnson they had the safety blitz on. I still don't see how Jimmy avoided being sacked.

"Jimmy Jordan played very well today.

"Going into this game I felt it would go one of two ways--(1) we would blow them out; or, (2) they (Oklahoma State) would win

"They ripped us right in the teet of our defense--running the ball up the middle. I would never have thought they could have done that.

"This week was the reverse of last. Our offense held us up until defense could get going.

"Those two quick touchdowns we ~~made~~ got were self inflicted. We forced their mistakes.

"Scott Warren (No. 80) impressed me on defense tonight.

"I didn't think our offensive line knocked them off the ball when we were trying to run the ball. When we rushed we didn't control the line of scrimmage.

"We try to execute the passing game by telling our kids the only way it can be stopped is by our stopping ourselves.
