### Ron Simmons

"Just what I anticipated-I wasn't at all surprised."

"I felt they could play over their heads. When you make a team a 20-30 underdog you know they're going to play better."

"They put a lot of stunts on me, but that just someone else free to go inside."

"Words can't explain how proud I am of the defense."

On Henry's return: "If the referee was in the way I would have hit him."

### Gary Henry

"I did return any at the beginning because I wanted to get a feel for the game."

"Yes, I could have run on some of them--I'm disappointed I didn't."

"Coach Bowden talked to me about returning punts--about the same time I was getting booed."

"The next time down I was determined I was going to run the ball."

"I was just concerned that we won the game."

"I was close to being out of bounds--less than a yard."

"I saw that last defender and I made the cut."

### Wally Woodham

"The guys were getting open, but I just couldn't hit them."

"I didn't feel that confident this game--that's why I wanted to go with the short passes."

### Ivory Joe Hunter

"That lick got me playing football again."

From Southern Miss. Coach Bobby Collins

"We played an excellent defensive game."

On the blocked punt: "I'm not sure whether there was a breakdown. We will have to see the film to determine where it was if there was a breakdown. We know the pressure came from the left side."

On the punt return (for the TD): "It looked like our contain man on the right side was blocked out of bounds, and the return man (Greg Henry) ~~maintained~~ out-ran the pursuit the opposite way."

Concerning Florida State: "I've said all along that one of their strong points was their defense. They proved that tonight. In the second half they switched to the 'flex' defense, which ~~gave~~ gave them better pursuit. We didn't manage to generate much offense in the second half."

Concerning USM: "Even in losing I think we proved we're a good football team, and if ~~you~~ you don't believe it, you should ask some of the Florida State players. We illustrated that we can go out there and play with anyone... That we're not 21-point underdogs to anyone--even Florida State."

Continuing on defense by USM: "We tried not to gibe them anything... It was a super defensive effort.
