

# The Florida State SEMINOLES

THIS YEAR: FSU coach Bobby Bowden said before the season that he was looking for general improvement again in 1979.

In their last two seasons the Seminoles have registered records of 10-2 (1977) and 8-3 (1978). Records like that are hard to improve on, but if ever there was a team that could, it's Florida State.

On paper the Seminoles may have one of their best teams with 18 starters back. On the field they're proving it with a 3-0 mark and national ranking.

Bowden's squad is blessed with experience. Five players — receiver Jackie Flowers, offensive guard Mike Good, fullback Mark Lyles, defensive tackle Walter Carter and defensive end Scott Warren — are four year starters.


Also on hand are senior quarterbacks Jimmy Jordan and Wally Woodham, who give FSU perhaps the best quarterbacking duo in the nation. The last two seasons they have shared starting duty, and both already rank in the top 10 in most Seminole passing

So far this season Jordan has hit on 20 of 48 passes for 270 yards and three touchdowns, while Woodham has connected on 24 of 45 attempts for 258 yards and one score.

With Flowers, Phil Williams and Sam Platt, the Seminole signal callers have a super combination of wide receivers to call on. Flowers, who led the squad in catches last season, has 10 to his credit this year for 164 yards and two touchdowns.

Lyles and tailback Greg Ramsey provide a solid tandem of running backs, while along the offensive front there is a veteran starter at all but one spot.

Despite their reputation for offense, however, the real key to this year's Seminole squad may be defense. Led by premier noseguard

Ron Simmons (6-1, 235, Jr.), the FSU defense has been outstanding.

Among those aiding Simmons in stabilizing the defense have been Warren, linebacker Paul Piurowsky and a talented secondary, which includes Monk Bonasorte — who already has four interceptions to his credit.

The kicking game is also solid with punter Rohn Stark nationally-ranked (42.4 average), kicker Dave Cappelen leading the squad in scoring (20 pts.; 4-5 in field goals) and freshman punt returner Gary Henry with two touchdown returns already under his belt.

LAST YEAR: Despite an 8-3 mark in '78, somehow a bowl bid eluded the Seminoles. Honors, however, did not.

Five FSU players were named first team All-South Independent and two more earned second team recognition. Among those seven honorees, five — Simmons, Jordan, Good, Flowers and Cappelen — returned this season. Simmons, Good and Flowers were all first team picks.

THE COACH: Bobby Bowden

(Samford '53) is in his fourth season as head coach at Florida State. His overall record at FSU is currently 26-11, including a 3-0 mark this season. He has also held head coaching positions at South Georgia Junior College (1955-58), Samford (1959-62) and West Virginia (1970-75). Bowden was an assistant coach for three years (1963-65) at FSU, and served as offensive coordinator at West Virginia for four seasons before taking over as head coach. He will be seeking his 100th victory as a head coach today. His overall coaching record is 99-43 (.697), including a 6-0 record versus Tech.


