

# **VINCE GIBSON**

### HEAD FOOTBALL COACH

As he heads into his fifth season as University of Louisville head football coach, Vince Gibson could relax, look back at the accomplishments and say to himself, "Good job." You can bet your last penny he won't

relax and congratulate himself. If anything, the RED RAGE mentor will drive himself and his coaching staff even harder as they head into the 1979 slate, rated by Cardinal followers as the toughest in school history.

When he arrived on the scene five years ago, Gibson inherited a program which was rapidly sliding downward. He has since turned it into one of the

South's top independents.

Last season, Gibson's team cruised to their second straight seven win season, and narrowly missed out on the team's return to postseason bowl action, having played in the 1977 Independence Bowl.

A 1955 graduate of Florida State University where he started on the of-fensive line, Gibson also holds a Mas-ter's (1956) in physical education and

guidance from FSU.

The 46-year old Birmingham, Alabama native started his coaching career in 1956 at South Georgia Junior College. He later accepted a defensive coaching job at his alma mater, working at FSU from 1958 to 1963.

Gibson left the Florida State Semi-noles in 1964 to accept a similar posi-tion at the University of Tennessee and was with the Volunteers through 1966, leaving to take over as head coach of the Big 8's Kansas State University.

At Kansas State, Gibson compiled a highly respectable 33-52 eight year rec-ord against what many feel was one of the toughest football conferences in the nation. During his tenure at KSU he guided the Wildcats to a second place conference finish in 1970 and by then had defeated every Big 8 team at least once.

The KSU Wildcats posted a 6-5 record in 1970 and Gibson was honored as Big 8 Coach of the Year, earned Na-tional Coach of the Year honors from the New York Daily News and was selected as Playboy's preseason Coach of the Year the following season.

The RED RAGE mentor has also been extremely active in postseason all-star games. He served as head coach in the 1974 East-West Shrine game in San Francisco, as head coach in the All-American Bowl in Tampa in '74, and last year was co-head coach of the Gray squad in the Blue-Gray all-star game in Birmingham, Alabama.

For Gibson, coaching is a full time job. He enjoys golf and harness racing, but they are strictly diversions to help him unwind from the rigors of the coaching world.

His philosophy towards his life as a

coach is simple. "Coaching football is my life. You work 12 hours a day, seven days a week for ten months when you're a coach and that doesn't leave much time for other activities. You have to love coaching football. If you don't then you need to be in some other field.'

Gibson's family is just as athletically involved as is the head coach. One son, Greg, a former defensive back for his dad at U of L, is now a graduate assistant for Johnny Majors at the University of Tennessee. A daughter, Pam, is married to former three year starting tackle, Mark Pongonis. Another son, Larry, is a standout football player and wrestler at Louisville's Trinity High School, and his other daughter, Janet, is one of the RED RAGE's most vocal supporters.

Football fans tonight should be treated to one of the best shows this side of Happy Days, Love Boat, or ABC-TV Monday Night Football. Florida State brings to Fairgrounds Stadium its nationally acclaimed "aerial circus" with co-pilots Wally Woodham and Jimmy Jordan. Both signal callers are equally dangerous and have picked more than one opponent to pieces with their pinpoint passing skills.

Woodham has accounted for over 3,000 career passing yards while Jordan has accounted for almost 3,500 yards. Little wonder that last season one of Sports Illustrated's writers, Mike Del Nargo, dubbed FSU's two-headed quar-terback corp "Wally Jim Jordham."

Coach Bobby Bowden's Seminoles have been picked to finish undefeated and challenge for the national title this year, but his lifelong friend, our very own Vince Gibson, would love nothing better than to put a crimp in those plans. Gibson summed up his feelings for Bowden and the importance of the game in a statement earlier this week. As Gibson put it, "I'm tickled to death that Florida State and Bobby are doing so good. Nothing would please me more than to see them finish with a "10-1" record and rank among the nation's

Certainly the Florida State program is no flash-in-the-pan program. The

last two years Bowden has guided the Seminoles to 10-2 (1977) and 8-3 (1978) finishes. Besides the quarterback situation other reasons for optimism in the FSU camp are the 18 starters and 45 lettermen back from last year's

Stopping FSU's eight game winning streak will be no mild undertaking for the RED RAGE. Yet Gibson feels his squad is more than capable of pulling one of the upsets of the year. As Gibson claims, "It almost happened last year (a big upset) in our Maryland game. I think that one proved to our team what they were capable of doing. Give us a break or two tonight, let us break a big play or two, or let FSU be looking past us and we can slip
