THE RANKINGS: Florida State rates fifth in both the Associated Press and United Press International Top 20 polls this week. It's the highest ranking of the season for the Tribe.

NCAA RANKINGS--Seminoles rank in both individual and team categories this week.

- (1) Placekicker Bill Capece leads the nation in field goals with 2.37 per game--19 in 24 attempts. He also ranks second in scoring with a 10.4 points per game average. Sammy Winder of Southern Mississippi is the leader at 12.0 points per game.
- (2) Quarterback Rick Stockstill ranks 21st in passing efficiency stats with a 125.7 rating points. Jim McMahon of Brigham Young is the leader with 164.6 rating points.
- (3) Punter Rohn Stark ranks second with a 45.8 yard average per kick. Michigan's Ray Stachowicz is the leader at 46.6.
- (4) In team categories, FSU is ninth in scoring offense (32.4), fifth in total defense (216.2), rushing defense (88.9), scoring defense (7.9) and leads in net punting (43.1).

THE SERIES: This is the fourth meeting between the two schools. FSU has a 3-0 advantage with wins in 1969 (38-20), 1971 (45-10) and 1972 (23-21).

CAPECE NEARS RECORDS: Seminole kicker Bill Capece is closing in on several records, school and NCAA Division I-A.

- (1) He has now scored 83 points and is just four shy of establishing a new school single season record. The present mark is 86 held by wide receiver Barry Smith since the 1972 season.
- (2) His 19 field goals is four shy of setting a new NCAA I-A record. The record is 22 held by Penn State's Matt Bahr since the 1978 season. Bahr's record came in 27 attempts.
- (3) He's within 15 points of establishing a new NCAA record for points scored by a kicker. Bahr set the record (97) during the 1977 season when he kicked 22 field goals and 31 PATs.

NEXT WEEK: Florida State entertains Virginia Tech at 7 p.m. while Tulsa hosts Indiana State.

- ...Tribe quarterback Rick Stockstill throws for 52 yards he will have 1,000 for the season
- ...Seminole defensive back Monk Bonasorte intercepts a pass he will add to his career total--presently 14--the best ever for a Seminole
- ...Tulsa blocks a Rohn Stark punt it will be the first he has had blocked at FSU
- ...the Seminole defense scores a shutout it will be their third of the season
- ...Tulsa scores a shutout it will be the first blanking of FSU since the 1976 season when Miami won a 47-0 verdict
- ...Florida State is limited to eight or less points it will be a season low
- ...Tulsa is limited to two or less points it will be a season low
- ...FSU scores 64 or more points it will be a season high
- ...Tulsa scores 45 or more points it will be a season high
- ...a Seminole scores three touchdowns it will be an individual season high

"Our kids played good tonight...the offensive line sure played good football. I think we were in control most of the game except for that second quarter. I don't think we hardly touched the ball that quarter. Jackson (Tulsa quarterback) reminded me of the Houston quarterback a couple of years ago; he was so quick.
