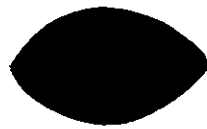

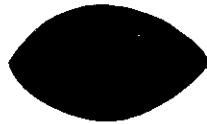

COACHES' QUOTES

COACH WALLY ENGLISH - TULANE

One of our players summed it all up and said tomorrow when they've got the top 10 on somebody out in Utah is going to say, My God, Tulane beat FSU. That's the way it came out and that's the way they played.

They went out there and gave great effort. We got the momentum going early in the ball game and we threw those two long pass interceptions and we turned the momentum over to FSU then they were ahead 21 to 14 at half time, we came in and told the kids just like 7 - 0 they were 7 point ap. We came back out and recaptured the momentum and I felt like our kids held on and played very very well in the second half.

I thought both Elton Veala and Mike Jones did very well. Toddy Francis came in there and ran several times. I thought both our starting two fullbacks and our starting running backs ran the ball very well.

We were in a double wing set. We had two tightends in the game and a single back a lot of times. Elton Veala was the single back a lot of times and I thought he played very well.

I thought Jon English played very well. He kept his cool, kept his poise and gave us the big plays when we needed them.

COACH BOBBY BOWDEN - FSU

Tulane just played great today. They played with fire and we made too many mistakes on offense to stay with them. We are not good enough to overcome all those mistakes.

That interception return early in the game set the tone for the whole day. Give them credit, that quarterback made play after play.

Our special teams are killing us. We were lucky to overcome our poor play in that first game (East Carolina), that's why it likes in a game like this to be playing at home.

They made big plays, one after another. They kept coming at us. Tulane's really got a quarterback who make the big plays.

We need to start stopping people on defense. We're never going to make it to the big time unless we can stop somebody.

That last long pass in the fourth quarter killed us. I felt like we still had a chance. They had 3rd down and a million and hit a bomb on us.
