Bo Schembechler: (on the game) "I thought it was an excellent football game. Our most pleasing victory this year. I feel we're better than last week, but still think we have to improve. It's our second year in a row that we've finished our non-conference season unbeaten.

GAME NOTES

MICHIGAN VS FLORIDA STATE

- * With the victory over the Seminoles, Bo Schembechler now has 199 career victories in Division I collegiate football. His career record stands at 199-55-7, with a 159-38-4 slate at Michigan.
- * Schembechler now has a record of 18-0 in Homecoming football contests.
- * Michigan's three (3) interceptions are the most by a Michigan defense in a game since October 5, 1985 versus Wisconsin...By forcing four Florida State turnovers, the Wolverines have taken the ball away 10 times in 1986, with five fumble recoveries and five interceptions.
- * For the second consecutive game, Michigan has not allowed an opponent to score in the third quarter...The Wolverines have given ~~xxx~~ up only six third quarter points all season (vs. Notre Dame);...Michigan has held its opponents to just 17 second half points in three games.
- * Both of the Michigan touchdowns came after FSU turnovers...The first came after Mark Messner recovered an FSU fumble at the Seminole 17, The second came after an Ivan Hicks interception at the Wolverine 47 yard line.
- * Offensive efficiency inside the Seminole 20 yard line--Michigan tallied two TD's and two FG's in six tries. The two blemishes were a missed 35 yard FG and a fourth down stop on the 18.
- * Florida State Offensive efficiency inside the Wolverine 20--The Seminoles had three chances inside the Michigan 20 yard line, scoring each time with two touchdowns and one field goal.
- * With 99 yards rushing this afternoon, Michigan tailback Jamie Morris has moved into 15th place on the all-time 'M' rushing list with 1919 career yards. Morris needs 29 yards to pass Rick Rogers (1981-84) for 14th...Morris now has rushed for 316 yards on 62 carries for a 5.0 average...With 45 yards in kickoff returns, Morris moved into second place on the 'M' Career list, trailing only Anthony Carter in KO return yards.
- * Thomas Wilcher carried the football nine times for 53 yards in the fourth quarter alone...It was his finest day since Oct. 5 1986, when he rushed 10 times for 67 yards against Wisconsin...Last season, Wilcher gained 106 yards on 16 carries at South Carolina.
- * Michigan quarterback Jim Harbaugh was 9-16 for 122 yards today...On the season, Harbaugh has completed 38 of 57 attempts for 532 yards, three TD's and one interception...On the career passing lists, Harbaugh stands fourth in pass Attempts with 400, 25 behind third place Don Moorhead...Harbaugh is third in passing yardage with 3252 aerial yards. Rick Leach is second with 4284...Harbaugh has 245, just five behind second place Rick Leach...Harbaugh stands eighth in total offense with 3427 yards, 11 behind Michigan Heisman Trophy winner Tom Harmon.
- * Harbaugh has thrown only one interception in the last ten games... His record as a starting qb at Michigan stands at 16-3-1 (16-2-1 excluding the 1984 Michigan State contest which he did not finish.
- * Michigan exceeded 100000 in the attendance column for the 68th consecutive game, dating back Oct. 25, 1975 versus Indiana.
- * Ivan Hicks' two interceptions today marked the first time that a Wolverine had more than one pick-off in a game since Oct. 5, 1985 versus Wisconsin, when Hicks ~~again~~ garnered two steals in a five interception effort by the Michigan defense.

COACHES QUOTES

Bo Schenbeckler: (on the game) "I thought it was an excellent football game. Our most pleasing victory this year. I feel we're better than last week, but still think we have to improve. It's our second year in a row that we've finished our non-conference season unbeaten.

Our defense played harder, tried harder and came up with some big plays.

(On Florida State): Florida State is a talented team. Excellent defensivley.

They ran a more balanced attack. Their cut-back hurt us badly in the first half. Once we stopped that (cut-backs), the defense was able to shut them down.

(On Thomas Wilcher): (Thomas) Wilcher with fresh legs really picked us up. Coach (Terril) Burton said he thought we should use Wilcher. He is a great attitude kid.

(On on side kick): On the on side kick off, two things happened. First, Florida State was off sides, and then the ball went out of bounds off us, I think it was Higgins. So, Florida State lost either ~~the~~ way.

(On play of Michigan offense): We played pretty well. We dented them up front (ran the ball); I liked that. It was a pleasing victory, beating Florida State. I have great respect for FSU.

(Final Thought): (On scoring drive in fourth quarter) Wilcher came in and sparked us on the drive, but we probably scored too quickly. We scored on second downs, we should have scored on fourth (joke).
