FLORIDA STATE

HEAD FOOTBALL COACH BOBBY BOWDEN

"The kids played well. We just had an excellent first half. McManus was really masterful. I thought all the quarterbacks played well. Gosh, I hope we haven't peaked. A lot of points were put up there by the defense. I really think our defense has been playing great...the last few weeks.

I don't even know what bowls want us. Can we take them all? I have no plans whatsoever to decide on a bowl. Our record hasn't been good enough to plan anything.

(On McManus): McManus is just quick as a cat. He'll throw the ball up in the stands in a flash. You think you're going to be second and long and he gets you second and five.

(On preparations for Florida): Disregard anything I've said ~~XXX~~ for the last five years. We've tried everything and nothing seems to work. We've tried preparing the summer before, on Christmas Day, on Leap Year; nothing has worked. I got a feeling you've got to be better than them before you can beat them."

SOUTHERN MISSISSIPPI

HEAD FOOTBALL COACH JIM CARMODY

"We played perhaps the best team we played this year, including Alabama and Texas A & M. They executed extremely well on offense and we did not make them turn the ball over defensively. I think that if perhaps we had been able to hold on to those first two interceptions we certainly would have had a different outlook, at least at that stage of the game. Again, they ~~XX~~ executed well offensively and play about as well defensively as we've seen them play all year. They have a fine football team; the people they've lost to are all nationally ranked and it looks like they're getting better as the season draws to a close.
