Florida State Head Coach Bobby Bowden

"Our defense set the pace right off the bat. We played a fine first quarter, but I thought they beat us in the second quarter. We did score just before the half to turn that around. We were not sharp offensively, but they did a good job. Coach Peace does an excellent job. We played a lot of people. We kept Sammie and Dexter out, and Victor for the most part. We're looking forward to having them all healthy. I don't know how bad Chip's injury is, but he wanted to go back in and that's a good sign. I thought all our quarterbacks did a good job under the circumstances. The first half was very rough and that disappointed me. I talked to them last night about walking away if somebody pushed or hit them. So I was disappointed with what happened. They were a scrappy team and our kids don't like to be pushed around. They have a fine university and players and we do too and that shouldn't happen. Thank goodness for Parker how many yards did he have. It's important that the pollsters don't overlook their mistake. When you're an independent, the polls are even more crucial and an oversight shouldn't cost you."

Louisiana Tech Head Coach Joe Raymond Peace

"They are a great football team and proved it again. You try to keep from giving up the big plays but we weren't able to -- just like some others haven't been able to....the kicking game did us in early. It self-destructed. Florida State is known for being able to block kicks and we were certainly concerned about that, but they have great speed and were able to get to us in the start. We finally worked that out some in the 2nd quarter..."

About FSU throwing at the end: "He has a job to do; it's all just part of the business. It did not upset me. He's concerned about the polls and post-season play so, no, I didn't worry about that. I think he is a class guy and has a class program."

'We felt they would try to intimidate us early, they have done that to some people and we knew that. I think our players were aware of that and maybe that's why there were a few problems out there. We got whipped but we didn't get intimidated."

FSÜ Notes

Chris Parker became the first FSU runningback to rush for over 100 yards in two games this season with 127 yards of 25 carries today against Louisiana Tech. Last week, Parker gained 158 yards.

Florida State's two interception returns for touchdowns today tied the FSU record.

The two INT returns for scores today by Dedrick Dodge and Deion Sanders gives Florida State six this season. Sanders also had one against Southern Miss and Tracy Sanders returned an interception against Tulane. LeRoy Butler had an interception return for a touchdown against Michigan State. That total breaks the FSU season record for touchdowns on interception returns which was four, set in 1985.

Five touchdown passes thrown by four different FSU quarterbacks ties arteam record for most TD passes in a game. The last time FSU had five touchdown passes in a game was in 1985 against Tulsa.

Deion Sanders now holds the Florida State records for most touchdowns on interception returns in a season and in a career with three. Today's interception return and TD was his second of the season.

Matt Stover's 52 yard field goal was the longest by an opponent this season.

Today's game marked the debut of the new Renegade which was brought on in the fourth quarter. The old Renegade is 21 years old.
