SOUTH CAROLINA GAME NOTES:

Tonight's 59-0 loss was the worst home defeat in South Carolina football history and the second worst defeat ever by a Gamecock team. The previous largest margin of defeat at home was 51-0 to Clemson in 1900, and the worst defeat was 63-0 at the hands of Navy at Annapolis in 1910.

South Carolina is now 7-2 on the season and both losses have been by shutouts, the Gamecocks having lost 34-0 at Georgia Tech three weeks ago. The last time South Carolina was shut out ~~more than once in a season~~ more than once in a season was 1967 when the Gamecocks were blanked three times, 21-0 at Georgia, 17-0 at Florida State, and 17-0 at Alabama.

Tonight's loss broke a 13 game Williams-Brice Stadium winning streak for South Carolina. Florida State beat the Gamecocks 45-28 in the next to last home game of 1986. After defeating Wake Forest in the final home game that season, South Carolina was 7-0 at home in 1987 and ~~for~~ 5-0 this season.

Todd Ellis failed to pass for 100 yards for the first time in his career. He completed nine of 23 passes for 79 yards. His previous loss in passing yardage was 141 against Miami in 1987 when he completed 10 of 28.

FLORIDA STATE GAME NOTES:

Peter Tom Willis is the first FSU quarterback to pass for four TDs since Eric Thomas in a 1984 game with Auburn.

Florida State's defense has not given up a touchdown in eight quarters, since the fourth quarter of the East Carolina game.

FSU is now on an eight game winning streak. It is the second-longest winning streak of Bobby Bowden's career at FSU. The longest is 15 games.

Peter Tom Willis broke the FSU record for completion percentage in a game with his 17 of 20 performance tonight. The previous record was 84 percent by Gary Huff in a 1971 game with Virginia Tech when he hit 21 of 25. Willis' total is good for 85 percent.

The shutout was Florida State's first since the 1986 season-opening 24-0 win over Toledo. It was also the first FSU shutout on the road since a 1980 season-opening 16-0 victory over Louisiana State in Baton Rouge.

Florida State's blocked punt was its fifth of the season, matching the team's 1987 total.

COACH MORRISON QUOTES:

"I thought we gave them a lot of momentum in the first quarter. The blocked punt and the interceptions...you just can't do that against PSU. They got on a roll and we couldn't stop them. We knew coming in that they were an excellent team. Turnovers were the difference early in the ball game. We kept shooting us ourselves in the foot. We never gave ourselves an opportunity to get back in the ball game."

COACH BOWDEN QUOTES:

"We played our ^{best} ball game and I'm sure South Carolina did not. To be honest with you, this is the healthiest we have been all year. The defense played the best game they have and that's the number one thing. The defense put it together for the first time this season and Peter Tom Willis was our most valuable player on the field tonight.

We haven't played this well since the Auburn game of last year. I told my team if we didn't peak this game, we weren't going to peak. We have just played good enough to win. We have played just about equal to our competition. Tonight we played like we're supposed to play football.

"They blitzed so much I was afraid we would not be able to pick it up. Usually a team that blitzes like that, they can get you or you get them. And we got them more than they got us."

SOUTH CAROLINA PLAYER QUOTES

Wide Receiver Robert Brooks ... "I had confidence in Todd to get me the ball tonight. I was open some of the time and not open on other plays. We made a lot of mental mistakes in the first quarter and we needed to bounce back; but we couldn't. We knew Florida State had great special teams and that's one place where the game was won tonight."

Free Safety Ron Rabune ... "It was a team loss tonight. We couldn't get anything generated on both the offense or defense. We didn't quit -- we got a lot of players in the game. We knew they were going to go downtown on us and we needed to stop them. They just outjumped and outmuscled us in the secondary. We had a lot of emotion coming into the game but it just wasn't all there tonight."

Quarterback Todd Ellis ... "We played a great team out there tonight. We never got anything together or any type of rhythm going on the field. Early, and for most of the game, they played different coverages than we were expecting. They even played double zone, a coverage that I had heard their coach hates to play. We just never got an opportunity to do anything. In a landslide like tonight, things just don't happen right all night. Basically, what we were getting from them on the field wasn't what we were expecting."

OPPOSING PLAYER QUOTES

P.T. Willis QB-- I was a little nervous at first but after the big play I loosened up alot. I think we have got the best receivers in the country. After the first touchdown pass all my nervousness turned into excitement.

Deion Sanders CB-- We never thought that it was going to be like this, but we did come in here with the idea that we could win. Everything clicked and everything worked out for itself. I'm never satisfied with any victory. We kept (Todd) Ellis off balance. We definately were not looking past South Carolina. South Carolina was defnatly a determining point for a lot of things -- most importantly the bowl picture. South Carolina was more worried about a lot of other things, I think, than stopping our offense of defense.

Terry Anthony, WR -- I think we have one of the best receiving teams in the country. I don't think that there's a group of receivers in the nation who can stand in the same room with us.
